RESOLUTION NO. R-2022-271

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, RANKING CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT AT RISK FIRMS AND AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE CONTINUING SERVICES AGREEMENTS WITH THE HIGHEST-RANKED FIRMS IN EACH TIER LEVEL TO PROVIDE CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT AT RISK SERVICES FOR GENERAL OBLIGATION BOND, CITY CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS, AND OTHER CITY PROJECTS.

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to enter into Continuing Services Agreements ("CSAs") with multiple Construction Management at Risk ("CMAR") contractors to provide CMAR services that may be required to implement future capital improvements, General Obligation Bond ("GOB"), or other City projects; and

WHEREAS, services to be accomplished under these CSAs may include various future unidentified projects that may include but not be limited to capital improvements, GOB, or other City projects with an individual, project-estimated construction value not to exceed \$4,000,000.00 pursuant to Section 287.055 (2)(g), Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the City has followed the procedures set forth in Section 287.055, F.S., entitled "Consultants' Competitive Negotiation Act" ("CCNA"), Section 255.103, F.S., entitled "Construction Management or Program Management Entities", and the City's Procurement Code to advertise and solicit Statements of Qualifications ("SOQs") from CMAR firms; and

WHEREAS, Request for Qualifications No. RFQ-4721-22-GJ ("RFQ") was issued on March 23, 2022 to promote competition and solicit SOQs from CMAR firms in three tiers with individual submittals and rankings for each; and

WHEREAS, Tier 1 is for construction projects with an estimated cost under \$500,000.00, Tier 2 is for construction projects with an estimated cost from \$500,000.00 to \$2,000,000.00, and Tier 3 is for construction projects with an estimated cost from \$2,000,000.00 to \$4,000,000.00; and

WHEREAS, on May 3, 2022, the Office of the City Clerk, Division of Procurement Services, and the Department of Design and Construction Management ("DCM") received SOQs from CMAR firms for each tier as follows:

WHEREAS, CMAR services for specific projects will be requested on an "as needed-when needed" basis; and

WHEREAS, the initial term of the CSAs will be for three years with the right to renew the contracts for two subsequent one-year terms based on satisfactory performance and mutual agreement; and

WHEREAS, in addition to the CSA contracts, the selected firms will be required to execute Phase 1 Preconstruction Contracts and Phase II Construction Contracts when retained for the specific project in accordance with Section 255.103, F.S.; and

WHEREAS, DCM recommends that the City Commission authorize the appropriate City officials to execute the attached Continuing Service Agreement with each of the recommended highest-ranked firms to provide CMAR services as set forth above.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA.

<u>Section 1</u>: That the foregoing 'WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.

Section 2: That it approves and authorizes the appropriate City officials to execute the attached Continuing Service Agreement with each of the highest-ranked firms in each of the Tier levels, together with such non-material changes as may be subsequently agreed to by the City Manager and approved as to form and legal sufficiency by the City Attorney.

<u>Section 3</u>: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
