

RESOLUTION NO. R-2024-342

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, AWARDED INVITATION FOR BID IFB-223-24-AR FOR THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD DISTRICT 1-4 & 6 TRAFFIC CALMING IMPROVEMENTS TO THE STOUT GROUP, LLC; APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH THE STOUT GROUP, LLC FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE DISTRICT 1-4 & 6 TRAFFIC CALMING IMPROVEMENTS SPEED TABLES, A GENERAL OBLIGATION BOND PROJECT, IN AN AMOUNT UP TO \$700,408.00.

WHEREAS, in March of 2019, the voters passed the General Obligation Bond, which included provisions to set funding aside in the amount of \$2,189,119.00 for the establishment of a Traffic Calming Program ("Program") to address safety concerns raised by residents regarding vehicular speeding and cut-through traffic in their neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, on March 4, 2020, the City Commission passed and adopted Resolution No. R-2020-056, approving and authorizing appropriate City officials to issue an Authorization to Proceed with Atkins North America, Inc. ("Atkins") for the establishment of the Program; and

WHEREAS, on June 2, 2021, Atkins presented to the City Commission their findings and status of the Program study; and

WHEREAS, on September 14, 2021, the City Commission passed and adopted Resolution No. R-2021-230, approving and authorizing appropriate City officials to issue an Authorization to Proceed with Atkins for Phase II to develop conceptual plans of the Program; and

WHEREAS, on July 6, 2022, the City Commission passed and adopted Resolution No. R-2022-191, approving and authorizing appropriate City officials to issue an Authorization to Proceed with Atkins for Phase II to provide professional engineering services for the design of traffic calming improvements within Districts 1, 2, 3, 4 and 6; and

WHEREAS, the design plans are completed and are being permitted under two separate sets of construction plans with Broward County Traffic Engineering and the City; and

WHEREAS, on July 23, 2024, the City advertised Invitation for Bid IFB-223-24-AR for District 1-4 & 6 Traffic Calming Improvements ("IFB-223-24-AR"), or more specifically, for construction services for District 1-4 & 6 Traffic Calming Improvements Speed Tables on www.Opengov.com; and

WHEREAS, on August 22, 2024, the Department of Procurement and Contract Compliance and the Department of Design and Construction Management ("DCM") received bids as follows:

WHEREAS, DCM and the Department of Procurement and Contract Compliance reviewed and evaluated the submitted bids in accordance with Section 38.43(F) of the City's Procurement Code and, after the evaluation, The Stout Group, LLC ("Stout Group") was determined to be the best value and the lowest responsive and responsible bid; and

WHEREAS, on September 5, 2024, a Notice of Intent of Award was posted on the City's website and on www.Opengov.com, and resulted in no bid protests by the deadline of September 16, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the Director of DCM and the Chief Procurement Officer recommend that the City Commission award IFB-223-24-AR to Stout Group and approve and authorize the appropriate City officials to execute a contract with Stout Group in an amount up to \$700,408.00; and

WHEREAS, the IFB-223-24-AR and contract award recommendation is for the speed tables scope of work, and the second set of construction plans for roundabouts and roadway realignments is currently in final design and permitting; and

WHEREAS, funding for this project was included in the amended FY 2025 Capital Improvement Plan and is available in account number 333.149901.54100.563010.001185.000.000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.

Section 2: That it awards IFB-223-24-AR to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder, Stout Group.

Section 3: That it approves and authorizes the execution, by the appropriate City officials, of a contract with Stout Group for the construction of the District 1-4 & 6 Traffic Calming Improvements Speed Tables Project, in a form acceptable to the City Manager and approved as to form by the City Attorney.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
