A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE CITY'S TITLE VI PROGRAM AND ASSURING THAT NO PERSON SHALL BE EXCLUDED FROM PARTICIPATION IN, DENIED BENEFITS OF, OR OTHERWISE BE SUBJECTED TO DISCRIMINATION OR RETALIATION UNDER ANY CITY PROGRAM OR ACTIVITY ON THE BASIS OF RACE, COLOR, NATIONAL ORIGIN, AGE, DISABILITY, FAMILY OR RELIGIOUS STATUS AS PROVIDED UNDER TITLE VI OF THE CIVIL RIGHTS ACT OF 1964, THE CIVIL RIGHTS RESTORATION ACT OF 1987, AND THE FLORIDA CIVIL RIGHTS ACT OF 1992.

WHEREAS, Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, the Civil Rights Restoration Act of 1987 and the Florida Civil Rights Act of 1992 require that no person shall be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination or retaliation on the basis of race, color, national origin, age, disability, family, or religious status; and

WHEREAS, on January 17, 2024, the City Commission passed and adopted Resolution No. R-2024-021 supporting the implementation of a Community Shuttle Program ("CSP") establishing three service routes within the City and authorizing the City Manager or designee to execute all applicable program documents and agreements associated with the Broward County CSP; and

WHEREAS, following execution of the Interlocal Agreement ("ILA"), the City CSP is a sub-recipient of Federal Transit Administration Funds ("FTA"); and

WHEREAS, FTA funding and the CSP ILA requires that the City Commission adopt the attached Title VI Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.

Section 2: That it approves and authorizes the adoption of the attached Title VI Program.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
