This is in reference to my letter dated July 22, 2016, listing the crossings scheduled for maintenance in the year 2017. The above-referenced grade crossing has declined to the point of requiring said maintenance. The Railway or our contractors will perform all work associated with the crossing to include maintenance of traffic and paving. We have scheduled this work to begin on **August 22, 2017.**

In accordance with the terms of the agreement dated June 7, 1972, the cost of the crossing maintenance is the responsibility of the CITY. The costs to the CITY are as outlined in the enclosed estimate, however this is an estimate only and all charges for which the CITY is responsible shall be billed on an actual cost basis. Additionally, the CITY will be responsible to replace the traffic loop sensors if they are damaged during construction. If this occurs, the new sensors must be installed behind the crossing warning device gate arm to better protect them during future crossing maintenance.

Please review the enclosed estimate, and if acceptable, please acknowledge this letter by providing a letter of authorization against which we may bill for this work.
