This Resolution seeks authorization for the appropriate City Officials to issue the attached Blanket Purchase Order (BPO) to Waste Pro of Florida, Inc. for grit pickup and disposal services in an estimated annual amount of \$61,560.00.

On October 26, 2016, Bid Number F-4537-17-RL was electronically advertised via BidSync in accordance with the City's Purchasing Ordinance, Section 38.42 (A). It was opened at 3:00 P.M. on November 16, 2016, and resulted in responses from two (2) bidders with Waste Pro of Florida, Inc. being deemed the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. The initial term of this agreement shall be for a two (2) year period beginning December 15, 2016 and ending December 14, 2018. By mutual agreement between the City and the awarded contractor the agreement may be renewed for two (2) additional two (2) year periods

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Funding for the attached Blanket Purchase Order has been provided for in the Fiscal Year 2017 Budget in the Department of Public Utilities Account Number 42.4041.00000.536.004360 - Waste Disposal and will be budgeted in subsequent fiscal years subject to the passage and adoption of each subsequent fiscal year's Operating Budget by the City Commission.

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
