I have reviewed the above-captioned agreement for form and legality, and the general business terms and other significant provisions are as follows:

- 5) Contract Amount Effective retroactive to 10/1/2017, bargaining unit members will receive an across-the-board 3% wage increase. A reformed planned retirement benefit will be created, similar to that already available to the PBA. For dependent medical coverage, a bargaining unit member with one dependent will pay \$130 bi-weekly (a \$40 reduction) and a bargaining unit member with two or more dependents will pay \$165 bi-weekly (a \$40 reduction).
