WHEREAS:	THE IMPROVEMENTS IN SURVIVAL RATES REFLECT PROGRESS IN DIAGNOSING CERTAIN CANCERS AT AN EARLIER STAGE AND ADVANCES IN CANCER TREATMENTS; AND
WHEREAS:	THESE EFFORTS HELP FUND GROUND-BREAKING RESEARCH, PROVIDE UP-TO-DATE CANCER INFORMATION, ADVOCATE FOR ALL PEOPLE TO HAVE ACCESS TO SCREENING AND TREATMENT, AND PROVIDE PROGRAMS
