A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING THE NORTH 29TH AVENUE PROJECT AS PART OF BROWARD COUNTY'S COMPLETE STREETS MASTER PLAN PROGRAM IN ORDER TO ESTABLISH FUNDING ELIGIBILITY BY THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION.

WHEREAS, on February 14, 2019, the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization ("MPO") approved the Broward Complete Streets Master Plan ("CSMP") Program; and

WHEREAS, the North 29th Avenue project from Sheridan Street to Stirling Road has been identified as a high-ranking project in the Complete Streets Master Plan's list of recommendations; and

WHEREAS, the North 29th Avenue project from Sheridan Street to Stirling Road will be constructed within the City right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, in order to establish funding eligibility for these projects, the MPO and the Florida Department of Transportation require that the City Commission pass and adopt a resolution of support for the project; and

WHEREAS, federally funded projects off the state highway system are delivered using the federally mandated Local Agency Program ("LAP") process; and

WHEREAS, the City acknowledges that the project will be delivered under LAP when the project is deemed eligible for funding; and

WHEREAS, the City commits to funding upfront costs for design, construction engineering and inspection (CEI) services, and construction for future reimbursement as per the LAP agreement and fund the construction contingency; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the LAP program the City will receive funding on a reimbursement basis; and

WHEREAS, the City's contributions to the CSMP project include the reimbursable upfront costs for design phase in 2025 in an estimated amount of \$875,000.00 and \$650,000.00 for construction engineering and inspection services and \$5,500,000.00 for construction in 2027 and non-reimbursable estimated amount of \$600,000.00 for construction contingency in 2027; and

WHEREAS, the CSMP project funding is intended to be included in a future Capital Improvement Plan subject to the approval and adoption by the City Commission; and

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of the City to maintain or coordinate the maintenance of the roadway after the project's completion; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Development Services, Engineering, Transportation and Mobility Division recommends the City Commission continue to support this project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA.

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.

Section 2: That it supports the North 29th Avenue project from Sheridan Street to Stirling Road as part of the CSMP project.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
