If the organization has been in the program and changed name and location the site will be considered a new site. Please ensure that all questions on the application are completed and submitted as soon as possible. Incomplete applications will be delayed in processing.

Additionally, please note, all sites receiving meal service must either be an IRS-APPROVED 501(c)(3) non-profit organization, government entity <u>OR</u> must complete the enclosed For Profit Site Certificate. Please attach a copy of your 501(c)(3) designation OR the For-Profit Site Certificate with your application packet.

<u>This year, the Summer Food Service Program will operate from June 8 to August</u> <u>21, 2015.</u> The program's training schedule will be forwarded to you at a later time. However, please note, <u>ALL</u> staff person's must successfully complete the training in order for your site to be certified to receive meals.
