A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, RANKING THE PROPOSERS FOR THE OPERATION OF AFTER SCHOOL AND SUMMER CAMP PROGRAM SERVICES, AND FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE HIGHEST RANKED PROPOSER AND THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD.

WHEREAS, the Parks, Recreation and Cultural Arts Department requires an agreement with a qualified firm for operating selected after school and summer camp programs; and

WHEREAS, Notices of Request for Proposals number RFP-4267-11-JE were mailed and the RFP was advertised on-line via the City's website and DemandStar in accordance with the City's Purchasing Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, RFP-4267-11-JE was opened at 3:00 P.M. on February 24, 2011, and resulted in responses from two (2) firms:

- After School Programs, Inc. Deerfield Beach, Florida
- Sunshine After School Child Care, Inc.
   Plantation, Florida

; and

WHEREAS, evaluation of the submitted proposals was based upon the criteria as established in the Request for Proposals as follows: Experience and Financial Stability; Project Organization and Technical Qualifications of the Persons Assigned to the Project; Project Understanding, Proposed Approach and Methodology; Revenue Benefit and Fee Structure to the City of Hollywood; and References and Success in Completing Similar Projects; and

WHEREAS, on March 23, 2011 an evaluation committee consisting of the Director, Parks, Recreation and Cultural Arts; Assistant Director, Parks, Recreation and Cultural Arts; Recreation Manager, and the two Recreation Supervisors met and ranked the two responses as follows:

- 1. Sunshine After School Child Care, Inc.
- 2. After School Programs, Inc.

WHEREAS, the Evaluation Committee has recommended that the City Commission authorize the negotiation and execution of an agreement with the highest ranked proposer: Sunshine After School Child Care, Inc., Plantation, Florida, for the operation of an after school program and summer camp program; and

WHEREAS, Sunshine After School Child Care, Inc. shall pay the City 25% of its gross receipts from summer camp programs and 5% of its gross receipts from after school programs and will be responsible for all operating costs of the programs; and

WHEREAS, the Evaluation Committee recommends that should the City be unable to reach an agreement with the highest ranked proposer, that the City Commission further authorizes the negotiation and execution of an agreement with the second highest ranked proposer: After School Programs, Inc., Deerfield Beach, Florida, for the operation of an after school program and summer camp program; and

WHEREAS, the agreement will be for a three (3) year period with an option to renew for two (2) additional one (1) year periods subject to vendor acceptance and the determination that renewal will be in the best interest of the City; and

WHEREAS, Sunshine After School Child Care, Inc. has provided After School and Summer Camp Services over the past three (3) years and their services have been satisfactory; and

WHEREAS, Section 38.40(C)(5) of the City's Purchasing Ordinance provides that, when it is in the best interest of the city, the Director may procure, without following formal contract procedure, all supplies, materials, equipment and contractual services which are the subject of contracts with the state, its political subdivisions, the United States government, other governmental entities, or a corporation not for profit whose members are governmental entities, public officers, or any combination thereof; provided, however, that this subsection shall apply only if (i) the supplies, materials, equipment or contractual services are the subject of a price schedule negotiated by the state or the United States government, or (ii) the supplies, materials, equipment or contractual services are the subject of a contract with another governmental entity or a corporation not for profit whose members are governmental entities, public officers, or any combination thereof, which contract is based strictly on competitive bids or competitive proposals and not on any preference;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

<u>Section 1:</u> That it hereby ranks the proposers for the operation of after school and summer camp programs as follows:

; and

- 1. Sunshine After School Child Care, Inc.
- 2. After School Programs, Inc.

<u>Section 2</u>: That it hereby approves and authorizes the execution, by the appropriate City Officials, of an agreement embodying the terms and conditions approved by the City Commission this date between the first ranked proposer, Sunshine After School Child Care, Inc. and the City of Hollywood, in a form acceptable to the City Manager and approved as to form and legality by the City Attorney.

Section 3: That in the event that the City is unable to reach a mutually acceptable agreement with the first ranked proposer, Sunshine After School Child Care, Inc., that it hereby approves and authorizes the negotiation and execution, by the appropriate City Officials, of an agreement embodying the terms and conditions approved by the City Commission this date between the second ranked proposer, After School Programs, Inc. and the City of Hollywood, in a form acceptable to the City Manager and approved as to form and legality by the City Attorney.

Section 4: That relevant programs that are not specifically included in this RFP may be added during the term of the agreement under terms and conditions negotiated and approved by the City Manager or his designee, the Director of Parks, Recreation and Cultural Arts.

<u>Section 5</u>: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
