- WHEREAS,** VIOLENCE AND RISKY BEHAVIORS HAVE BECOME A SERIOUS PROBLEM IN OUR COMMUNITIES AND SOCIETY AT LARGE, WITH GREAT IMPLICATIONS FOR THE WELL-BEING AND FUTURE OF OUR CHILDREN; AND
- WHEREAS,** SINCE 2010, THE CHOOSE PEACE – STOP VIOLENCE INITIATIVE HAS WORKED WITH PARTNERS, COMMUNITIES AND YOUTH TO ADDRESS THE TERRIBLE REALITY OF YOUTH VIOLENCE. THE INITIATIVE IS A COLLABORATIVE EFFORT LED BY THE UNITED WAY OF BROWARD COUNTY, THE SCHOOL BOARD OF BROWARD COUNTY AND THE CHILDREN’S SERVICES COUNCIL OF BROWARD COUNTY; AND
- WHEREAS,** BROWARD COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS KICKS OFF EACH SCHOOL YEAR WITH A FOCUS ON CREATING A SAFE AND VIOLENCE FREE ENVIRONMENT WHERE PEACE AND INCLUSIVENESS ARE CELEBRATED. THIS YEAR’S CHOOSE PEACE – STOP VIOLENCE WEEK MOBILIZES SCHOOLS AND YOUTH LEADERS AS CATALYSTS FOR CHANGE; AND
