#### NOTE 1: DESCRIPTION OF BUSINESS AND SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The Company is primarily engaged in the installation of underground sewer and water supply systems in Southeast Florida.

The following is a summary of the Company's significant accounting policies:

#### **Revenue Recognition**

The Company records revenue on construction contracts by the percentage of completion method. The percentage of completion is determined by the ratio of costs incurred to estimates of total costs to be incurred. Losses on contracts are provided for in their entirety when estimates indicate that a loss will be incurred. Changes in job performance, job conditions, and estimated profitability may result in revisions to costs and income, which are recognized in the period in which the revisions are determined. A contract is considered complete when all costs except insignificant items have been incurred or when the work performed under the contract has received final acceptance from the owner. Because of the inherent uncertainties in estimating costs and revenues, it is reasonably possible that the estimates used will change within the near term.

#### Concentration of Risk

The Company maintains their cash balances in a single financial institution. The balances, at times, may exceed federally insured limits.

#### Accounts Receivable

The Company considers accounts receivable to be fully collectible based on prior experience of collections; accordingly, no allowance for doubtful accounts has been provided.

#### **Fixed Assets**

Machinery, transportation equipment, office equipment and leasehold improvements are recorded at cost and are depreciated using the straight-line method over the following estimated useful lives:

Maintenance, repairs and renewals, including replacement of minor items to physical properties, are charged to income; major additions to physical properties are capitalized.

Depreciation expense was \$241,063 and \$232,579 for the years ended November 30, 2012 and 2011, respectively.

#### Income Taxes

The Company has elected by unanimous consent of its stockholders to be taxed as an "S" Corporation under provisions of the Internal Revenue Code. Under those provisions, the Company does not pay federal corporate income taxes on its taxable income. Instead, the stockholders are liable for individual federal income taxes on their respective shares of the Company's taxable income.

The Company has adopted accounting rules that prescribe when to recognize and how to measure the financial statement effects of income tax positions taken or expected to be taken on its income tax returns. These rules require management to evaluate the likelihood that, upon examination by relevant taxing jurisdictions, those income tax positions would be sustained. Based on that evaluation, the Company only recognizes the maximum benefit of each income tax position that is more than 50% likely of being sustained. To the extent that all or a portion of the benefits of an income tax position are not recognized, a liability would be recognized for the unrecognized benefits, along with any interest and penalties that would result from disallowance of the position. Should any such penalties and interest be incurred, they would be recognized as operating expenses.

Based on the results of management's evaluation, adoption of the rules did not have a material effect on the accompanying financial statements. Consequently, no liability is recognized in the accompanying balance sheets for unrecognized income tax positions. Further, no interest or penalties have been accrued or charged to expense as of November 30, 2012 and 2011, or for the years then ended. With limited exceptions, the Company is no longer subject to federal tax audits for years prior to 2009 and state tax audits for years prior to 2008.

#### **Cash Flows**

For purposes of the Statements of Cash Flows, the Company considers all highly liquid debt instruments purchased with a maturity of three months or less to be cash equivalents.

#### Subsequent Events

Management has evaluated subsequent events through February 15, 2013, the date on which the financial statements were available to be issued.
