A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE THE ATTACHED CONTRACT BETWEEN STONEHENGE CONSTRUCTION, LLC AND THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD FOR BEACH MAINTENANCE FACILITY – PHASE I BRIDGE LOT, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$339,882.00.

WHEREAS, in the summer of 2012, Beach Maintenance staff lost their facility at the Johnson Street Garage and have been temporarily relocated to an old Fire Station on A1A; and

WHEREAS, two (2) temporary locations have been identified to once again relocate Beach Maintenance staff; and

WHEREAS, one (1) of these locations is to an existing FDOT parking lot under the Hollywood Boulevard Bridge; and

WHEREAS, construction documents and specifications to renovate this area were prepared by a Consultant and the Notice to Bidders was advertised online via BidSync on September 7, 2016; and

WHEREAS, these construction documents and specification were viewed by seventy-two (72) vendors on BidSync and thirteen (13) downloaded them; and

WHEREAS, a Non-Mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting was held at the site on September 22, 2016 to review the existing conditions on site; and

WHEREAS, through receipt of the City's bid specifications for this project, all contractors have been provided with a copy of the City's contract, including the terms and conditions contained therein; and

WHEREAS, three (3) bids were received and publicly opened at 10:00 AM on September 29, 2016, and the responsive bids are as follows:

WHEREAS, City staff reviewed the three (3) bids and determined that the bid submitted by Stonehenge Construction, LLC (Stonehenge) was the overall lowest, responsive and responsible bid, and have recommended the award of the bid to Stonehenge in the amount not to exceed \$339,882.00; and

WHEREAS, on October 5, 2016 the City Commission approved R2016-291 which continued the appropriation for previously approved Capital Projects from FY 16 to FY 17 and included the funding for the Beach Maintenance Relocation Facility and is available in account number 34.5100.15514.519.006301;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That it hereby approves and authorizes the execution, by the appropriate City Officials, of the attached contract between Stonehenge Construction, LLC, and the City of Hollywood, together with such non-material changes as may be subsequently agreed to by the City Manager and approved as to form and legality by the City Attorney.

Section 2: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
