

SECOND AMENDMENT TO LETTER AGREEMENT

This Second Amendment to the Letter Agreement (this "Amendment") is effective as of the date of the last signature below (the "Effective Date"), by and between **SOUTH BROWARD HOSPITAL DISTRICT d/b/a MEMORIAL HEALTHCARE SYSTEM** ("Memorial") and **CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA** ("Hollywood").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS Memorial and Hollywood entered into that certain Letter Agreement for the purchase of medical supplies used by the City of Hollywood Fire Rescue and Beach Safety Department effective June 29, 2021 ("Letter Agreement"); and contemporaneously therewith, the parties also entered into certain Addendum to Agreement that amended the Agreement (the "Addendum" and together with the Letter Agreement, the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS Memorial and Hollywood desire to amend the Agreement in certain respects as stated below:

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing and the mutual covenants herein contained, and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt, mutuality and sufficiency of which the parties hereby acknowledge, Memorial and Hollywood mutually agree as follows:

- 1) Term Extension: The term of the Agreement is hereby extended for an additional three (3) years from the Effective Date of this Amendment. The Agreement shall not automatically renew upon expiration.
- 2) Termination for Convenience: Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the Agreement, either party may terminate the Agreement for convenience upon providing the other party with ninety (90) days' prior written notice.

3) No Other Changes: Except as specifically amended herein, all other terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
