A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO PROCESS A FINAL QUARTERLY PAYMENT FOR A NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT OF \$14,762.44 INCLUDING FEES TO THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF FINANCIAL SERVICES FOR SELF-INSURER ASSESSMENTS.

WHEREAS, the City of Hollywood (the "City") is certified by the State of Florida as a workers' compensation self-insurer; and

WHEREAS, as a certified self-insurer the City is subject to annual assessments by the Special Disability Trust Fund and the Workers' Compensation Administration Trust Fund; and

WHEREAS, each year the legislature specifies the rate of assessment for each fund; and

WHEREAS, the assessments are based on various factors including payroll and loss experience that are reported annually by the City to the State of Florida; and

WHEREAS, the total assessment for the Fiscal Year 2014 was \$56,022.95, to be paid in four installments; and

WHEREAS, the installments for the first three quarters have been paid; and

WHEREAS, the installment for the fourth quarter (\$14,762.44 (including fees)) is now due; and

RESOLUTION: AUTHORIZING A FINAL QUARTERLY PAYMENT FOR A NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT OF \$14,762.44 INCLUDING FEES TO THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF FINANCIAL SERVICES FOR SELF-INSURER ASSESSMENTS.

WHEREAS, funding has been identified and is available in Fiscal Year 2014 budget in the City's Self Insurance Fund (Fund 58);

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That it hereby approves and authorizes the payment of \$14,762.44 to the Florida Department of Financial Services.

Section 2: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
