

RESOLUTION NO. _____

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, CALLING FOR THE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 3, 2026; AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY CLERK TO TAKE CERTAIN ACTIONS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH; AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE BROWARD COUNTY SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS REGARDING THE ELECTION.

WHEREAS, the City has a districted form of elections with a Mayor elected at large and six Commissioners elected from districts, as established by the City Charter; and

WHEREAS, the City will be having a general election to be held on November 3, 2026 (the "General Election"); and

WHEREAS, the terms of the City Commissioners from Districts 1, 3, and 5, expire in November 2026; and

WHEREAS, in order to conduct the election, it is necessary to enter into the attached agreement with the Broward County Supervisor of Elections; and

WHEREAS, funding for the General Election is available in account number 001.111001.51200.549930.000000.000.000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.

Section 2: That the General Election shall be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November, which is November 3, 2026, between the hours of 7:00 AM and 7:00 PM, at polling places designated by the Broward County Supervisor of Elections.

Section 3: The City Commissioners from District 1, 3, and 5 will be elected to a four-year term.

Section 4: That the City Clerk is authorized and directed to place upon the ballot the names of all candidates properly qualifying for the General Election.

Section 5: That it approves and authorizes the execution by the appropriate City officials of the attached agreement with the Broward County Supervisor of Elections, together with such non-material changes as may be subsequently approved by the City Manager and approved as to form and legal sufficiency by the City Attorney.

Section 6: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
