A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE A BLANKET PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH THE SHYFT GROUP UPFIT SERVICES, INC., D/B/A STROBES-R-US, FOR THE SUPPLY AND INSTALLATION OF EMERGENCY AND RELATED EQUIPMENT FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT, FIRE RESCUE AND BEACH SAFETY, AND GENERAL FLEET VEHICLES IN AN ANNUAL AMOUNT UP TO \$840,000.00 OVER A THREE-YEAR PERIOD BASED UPON THE BROWARD SHERIFF'S OFFICE CONTRACT RLI #23004AP – EMERGENCY EQUIPMENT FOR VEHICLES IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 38.41(C)(5) OF THE PROCUREMENT CODE (PIGGYBACK).

WHEREAS, the Police Department, Fire Rescue & Beach Safety, and Fleet Management Division of the Public Works Department desire to outfit law enforcement, fire rescue and beach safety, and general fleet vehicles with emergency equipment such as light bars, sirens, speakers, interior and exterior warning lights, computer mounts, cages, and various additional related equipment and parts; and

WHEREAS, emergency equipment and installation services were competitively bid by the Broward Sheriff's Office ("BSO") pursuant to a Request for Letters of Interest ("RLI") #23004AP Emergency Equipment for Vehicles, which was awarded on April 20, 2023 to The Shyft Group Upfit Services, Inc., d/b/a Strobes-R-U's ("Strobes-R-U's"); and

WHEREAS, the current term of RLI #23004AP - Emergency Equipment for Vehicles is from June 9, 2023 through June 8, 2026, with an option to renew the contract for two additional one-year periods; and

WHEREAS, Strobes-R-U's has agreed to extend to the City the same pricing under the terms and conditions set forth in RLI #23004AP - Emergency Equipment for Vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the period of performance during which the vehicle emergency and related equipment will be acquired is over a three-year period from September 1, 2023 through June 8, 2026, with the option to renew for two additional one-year periods for an annual amount up to \$840,000.00; and

WHEREAS, Section 38.41(C)(5) of the Procurement Code allows the Chief Procurement Officer to procure, without formal solicitation procedures, all goods, supplies, materials, equipment, and services that are the subject of contracts with the state, its political

subdivisions, the United States government, other governmental entities, or a corporation not for profit whose members are governmental entities, public officers, or any combination thereof (“piggyback”), provided that the goods, supplies, materials, equipment, or services are the subject of a price schedule negotiated by the entities listed above and is based strictly on competitive bids, quotations, or competitive proposals and not on any preference and such utilization of other governmental entities contracts shall be permitted only during the term of the other governmental entity’s contract; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police and Chief Procurement Officer recommend that the City Commission approve and authorize the execution of the attached Blanket Purchase Agreement with Strobes-R-Us for the supply and installation of emergency equipment for law enforcement, fire rescue and beach safety, and general fleet vehicles in an annual amount up to \$840,000.00; and

WHEREAS, a portion of the funding for the attached Blanket Purchase Agreement is available in the FY 2023 Operating Budget and the amended FY 2023 Capital Improvement Plan in account numbers 557.209901.52100.564520.000000.000.000, 111.219801.52200.564530.000000.000.000, 001.215101.52200.552120.000000.000.000, 557.510101.51900.546320.000000.000.000 and 557.510101.51900.546420.000000.000.000, and will be budgeted in subsequent fiscal years’ operating budget and capital improvement plan subject to approval and adoption by the City Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing “WHEREAS” clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.

Section 2: That it approves and authorizes the execution, by the appropriate City officials, of the attached Blanket Purchase Agreement with The Shyft Group Upfit Inc., d/b/a Strobes-R-US, together with such non-material changes as may subsequently be agreed to by the City Manager and approved as to form by the City Attorney.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
