A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO APPLY FOR AND, IF AWARDED, ACCEPT THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF LAW ENFORCEMENT JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (COUNTYWIDE) IN THE APPROXIMATE AMOUNT OF \$7,000.00 FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF OVERTIME COSTS INCURRED FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE MARJORY STONEMAN DOUGLAS HIGH SCHOOL ACTIVE SHOOTER INCIDENT; FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE ALL APPLICABLE GRANT DOCUMENTS AND AGREEMENTS, AND IF AWARDED, AMENDING THE FY 2018 OPERATING BUDGET (R-2017-288) FOR THE POLICE GRANTS FUND (FUND 13).

WHEREAS, on February 14, 2018, an active shooter incident occurred at Marjory Stoneman Douglas High School in Parkland, Florida, which required response from the Hollywood Police Department, along with other local, regional, and state law enforcement personnel; and

WHEREAS, the involvement of the Hollywood Police Department in this incident resulted in unanticipated increased overtime costs; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Law Enforcement ("FDLE") has available a Justice Assistance Grant (Countywide) for the purpose of reimbursing overtime costs paid to sworn and civilian personnel who participated in the original February 14, 2018 incident and/or secondary peripheral security or investigative services related to the incident response; and

WHEREAS, it is understood that by the submission of the grant proposal, the City will abide by the terms and conditions set forth by the FDLE for use of said grant funds; and

WHEREAS, certain accounts will need to be established in the appropriate fund to recognize the receipt of grant funding, if awarded, and appropriate identified grant funding for grant related expenditures as detailed in Exhibit "1" attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police recommends that the appropriate City officials apply for the FDLE Justice Assistance Grant – Countywide for reimbursement of overtime costs related to the February 14, 2018 Marjory Stoneman Douglas High

School Active Shooter incident in the approximate amount of \$7,000.00, and further recommends the acceptance and execution of said grant upon its award.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.

Section 2: That it approves and authorizes the appropriate City officials to apply for FDLE Justice Assistance Grant (Countywide) for the reimbursement of overtime costs related to the Marjory Stoneman Douglas High School Active Shooter Incident Response in the approximate amount of \$7,000.00.

Section 3: That it authorizes the Department of Financial Services to create certain accounts to recognize revenue and appropriate program funding, if awarded.

Section 4: That the Amendments to the FY 2018 Operating Budget of the City of Hollywood for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2017 and set forth in detail in Exhibit "1" attached hereto are approved, adopted and authorized as Amendments to the Operating Budget of the Police Grants Fund (Fund 13) of the City for the Fiscal Year 2018, if the grant is awarded.

Section 5: That the City Manager is authorized to accept said grant, if awarded; provided, however, the City Manager shall have the discretion to refuse the grant in those circumstances where he determines it is in the best interests of the City to do so, in which case he shall advise the City Commission of his intention to refuse the grant.

Section 6: That upon FDLE Justice Assistance Grant - Countywide being awarded to the City, and the City Manager accepting said award, the appropriate City officials are authorized to execute all applicable grant documents and Grant Agreements, together with such non-material changes as may be subsequently agreed to by the City Manager and approved as to form and legal sufficiency by the City Attorney.

Section 7: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
