Explanation:

This Resolution seeks to authorize the appropriate City Officials to enter into and execute an agreement between The Center for Independent Living and the City of Hollywood to provide housing rehabilitation services to a minimum of two low and moderate income disabled homeowners for a cost not to exceed \$131,337.00. City staff has determined that it is not in the best interest of the City to go through a competitive bidding process in seeking these specialized services as the Center for Independent Living is uniquely qualified to evaluate the current housing needs of a special needs client and is experienced with certain continuing and possible future obstacles and adverse situations that might be encountered by the special needs client. The City's Purchasing Ordinance at §38.40 provides that when the City Commission declares by

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unanimous vote that competitive bidding and competitive proposals are not in the best interest of the City. Such purchases are exempt from competitive bidding and competitive proposal requirements.
