The program would install approximately \$500,000 of concrete sidewalks around 3 schools in FY 2020. The three locations being included are the area east of Oakridge Elementary, west of Avant Garde Academy and north of Beachside Montessori Village.

If awarded, this reimbursement funding will cover the cost of construction and the City will be responsible for associated costs such as design, surveying, consultant fees and testing. The City's portion of costs is estimated to be \$100,000 and funding can be made available subject to Commission approval through the adopted Capital Improvement Plan in the year of construction which is estimated to be FY 2019.
