

RESOLUTION NO. _____

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE FINAL RANKING FOR A MOBILE PARKING APPLICATION AND AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO NEGOTIATE A CONTRACT WITH THE HIGHEST RANKED FIRM, IPC TECHNOLOGY GROUP, LLC.

WHEREAS, the City of Hollywood desires to obtain a customized Mobile Parking Application to centralize and streamline parking-related services, integrate with existing systems, and enhance the overall customer experience by providing a modern, efficient, and user-friendly digital solution; and

WHEREAS, Section 38.43 of the Procurement Code states that when the estimated annual cost of goods, supplies, materials, equipment, or services exceeds \$50,000.00, a formal solicitation process shall be completed that may result in a written contract(s) and/or purchase order(s) after due public notice inviting bids or proposals; and

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2025, Request for Qualifications Number RFQ-282-25-SA ("RFQ") was electronically advertised on OpenGov.com to solicit the desired Mobile Parking Application in accordance with Section 38.43(A) of the Procurement Code; and

WHEREAS, the RFQ resulted in proposals from the following six firms by the response due date on April 14th, 2025 (listed in alphabetical order):

- 1) Allerin US Inc.
- 2) Ameg Enterprises LLC.
- 3) Chetu Inc.
- 4) IPC technology Group, LLC
- 5) Mobile Smart City Corp
- 6) Rock It LLC

; and

WHEREAS, on May 28, 2025, a Selection Committee met to evaluate and rank the proposals based upon the approved Evaluation Criteria established in the RFQ: Qualifications and Experience, Methodology & Approach to Scope of Work, System Compatibility, Data Security and Privacy, References, and Local Vendor Preference (Bonus); and

WHEREAS, the selection committee evaluated and ranked the firms as follows:

1. Mobile Smart City Corp - 98 points

2. IPC Technology Group, LLC - 79.13 points
3. Allerin US inc – 74.42 points
4. Chetu Inc- 70.18 points
5. AMEG Enterprises LLC – 68.83 points
6. ROCK IT LLC – 43.8 points

; and

WHEREAS, the top three ranked firms Allerin US Inc. IPC Technology Group, LLC, and Mobile Smart City Corp were shortlisted and invited to provide oral presentations for further consideration by the Selection Committee in its evaluation and selection of a firm; and

WHEREAS, on July 10, 2025, oral presentations were provided by the shortlisted firms, followed by a Public Evaluation Meeting during which the Selection Committee ranked the shortlisted firms; and

WHEREAS, scores were compiled to arrive at the following final rankings, with the lowest score being the highest ranked:

1. IPC technology Group, LLC (4 points)
2. Mobile Smart City Corp (5 points); and
3. Allerin US Inc (declined to present)

; and

WHEREAS, a Notice of Intent to Award was posted on July 14, 2025, for five business days and received no protests; and

WHEREAS, the Interim Director of Parking and Code Compliance and the Chief Procurement Officer recommend that the City Commission approve the final rankings and authorize the appropriate City officials to negotiate an agreement with the highest-ranked firm; and

WHEREAS, upon negotiating a contract with the highest ranked firm, if the contract amount falls within the City Manager's authority pursuant to Section 38.38 of the City's Procurement Code, the City Manager will execute the contract, but if it exceeds the City Manager's authority, the contract will be brought back to City Commission for consideration at a later date; and

WHEREAS, funding for these services was included in the amended FY 2025 Capital Improvement Plan in account number 446.159901.54500.564420.001903.000.000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA.

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.

Section 2: That it approves the ranking of the firms as follows (lowest score being the highest ranked):

1. IPC technology Group, LLC
2. Mobile Smart City Corp.

Section 3: That it authorizes the appropriate City officials to negotiate an agreement with the highest-ranked firm and authorizes the appropriate City officials to execute an agreement in a form acceptable to the City Manager and approved as to form and legal sufficiency by the City Attorney.

Section 4: That if the appropriate City officials are unable to negotiate an agreement with the highest-ranked firm, they are authorized to terminate negotiations with that firm and commence negotiations with the next highest-ranked firm, in order, until an agreement is reached.

Section 5: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
