

IN RECOGNITION OF NATIONAL HISTORIC PRESERVATION MONTH MAY 2016

WHEREAS: HISTORIC PRESERVATION IS AN EFFECTIVE TOOL FOR MANAGING GROWTH AND SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT, REVITALIZING NEIGHBORHOODS, FOSTERING LOCAL PRIDE, MAINTAINING COMMUNITY CHARACTER, AND ENHANCING LIVABILITY; AND
