A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE A COMMUNITY AESTHETIC FEATURE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD AND THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AFFIRMING THE CITY'S INTENT TO FUND ALL DESIGN, INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE PUBLIC ART UTILITY WRAP PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City desires to install 3M vinyl artwork to fifteen utility boxes located along Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") transportation facilities throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, FDOT agrees that transportation facilities that are enhanced by community aesthetic features can be beneficial to the public and result in positive economic development as well as increase tourism both locally and throughout the State of Florida; and

WHEREAS, FDOT requires the City to enter into a Community Aesthetic Feature Agreement ("Agreement") for the design and installation of community aesthetic features on rights-of-way owned by the FDOT, and for the maintenance costs associated with the Public Art Utility Wrap Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that authorizing the appropriate City officials to execute the Agreement between the City and FDOT is in the best interest of the citizens of Hollywood; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Development Services, the City Engineer, and the Chief Procurement Officer recommend that the City Commission approve and authorize the appropriate City officials to execute an Agreement between the City and FDOT affirming the City's intent to fund all designs, installation, and maintenance costs associated with the Public Art Utility Wrap Project on FDOT owned properties; and

WHEREAS, the artwork is subject the City's Public Art Committee review; and

WHEREAS, funding has been appropriated and is available in account number: 116.160502.51900.583440.001247.000.000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.

Section 2: That it approves and authorizes the appropriate City officials to execute the Agreement between the City and FDOT, affirming the City's intent to fund all design, installation, and maintenance cost associated with the Public Art Utility Wrap Project on FDOT Owned Properties, which Agreement is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "A."

Section 3: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
