A RESOLUTION OF THE HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY ("CRA"), APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CRA OFFICIALS TO ISSUE A BLANKET PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH MYDATT SERVICES, INC., D/B/A BLOCK BY BLOCK FOR COMMUNITY AMBASSADORS AND ENVIRONMENTAL CLEAN TEAM SERVICES IN AN AMOUNT UP TO \$500,000.00 BASED UPON 22-P-00519 YBOR CITY COMMUNITY AMBASSADORS AND ENVIRONMENTAL CLEAN TEAM IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 38.41(C)(5) OF THE PROCUREMENT CODE. (PIGGYBACK)

WHEREAS, the Community Redevelopment Agency ("CRA") desires to purchase Community Ambassadors and Environmental Clean Team Services ("Services") for the core of the Downtown District as these services are required to eliminate slum and blight; and

WHEREAS, the desired Services were competitively bid by the City of Tampa, Florida through Request for Proposal No. 41050322 on May 10, 2022, and awarded to Mydatt Services, Inc. d/b/a Block by Block ("Mydatt") under Agreement No. 22-P-00519 – Ybor City Community Ambassadors and Environmental Clean Team ("Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the current term of the Agreement is from October 1, 2025, through September 30, 2026; and

WHEREAS, Mydatt has agreed to extend to the CRA the same pricing under the terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the period of performance during which the desired Services is March 16, 2026, to September 30, 2026, for an amount up to \$500,000.00; and

WHEREAS, Section 38.41(C)(5) of the Procurement Code allows the Chief Procurement Officer to procure, without formal solicitation procedures, all goods, supplies, materials, equipment, and services that are the subject of contracts with the state, its political subdivisions, the United States government, other governmental entities, or a corporation not for profit whose members are governmental entities, public officers, or any combination thereof ("piggyback"), provided that the goods, supplies, materials, equipment, or services are the subject of a price schedule negotiated by the entities listed above and is based strictly on competitive bids, quotations, or competitive proposals and not on any preference and such utilization of other governmental entities contracts shall be permitted only during the term of the other governmental entity's contract; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Director of the CRA and Chief Procurement Officer recommend that the City Commission approve and authorize the issuance of a Blanket Purchase Agreement to Mydatt for Services from March 16, 2026, to September 30, 2026, in an amount up to \$500,000.00; and

WHEREAS, funding for the Blanket Purchase Agreement is available in account number 166.668602.55200.552010.000000.000.000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF THE HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY.

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.

Section 2: That it approves and authorizes the issuance, by the appropriate CRA officials, of a Blanket Purchase Agreement to Mydatt Services, Inc. d/b/a Block by Block, together with such non-material changes as may subsequently be agreed to by the Executive Director and approved as to form and legal sufficiency by the General Counsel.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
