

RESOLUTION NO. _____

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, APPOINTING ONE MEMBER TO THE AFRICAN AMERICAN ADVISORY COUNCIL.

WHEREAS, the City's African American Advisory Council ("AAAC") was created in 1993 to act as a liaison between the African American community and the City; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. R-93-352 established the AAAC, Resolution No. R-94-106 established the Board criteria, and Resolution No. R-97-116 increased the membership to 12 members; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. R-2005-293 increased the membership of the AAAC from 12 to 13, and created two alternate positions; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. R-2011-333 increased the number of alternate positions from two to three; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. R-2023-168 eliminated the alternate positions; and

WHEREAS, the current AAAC consists of 13 members; and

WHEREAS, there is currently one vacant position on the AAAC which was not filled; and

WHEREAS, the City Clerk provided notice to the public that positions were available and solicited interest forms from citizens to fill available vacancies; and

WHEREAS, the following individual has expressed a desire and willingness to fill the vacancy, namely:

1. Basil Phillips.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:
