- 4) Term of Contract

a) initial – Work to be commenced within 10 consecutive days after date of written Notice to Proceed and work shall be completed within 185 calendar days after the effective date established in the Notice to Proceed.
b) renewals (if any) – n/a. However, contract may be extended or shortening of contract may occur only by Change Order pursuant to Article 18.
c) who exercises option to renew – n/a

- 5) Contract Amount In the amount of \$1,790.891.00.
- 6) Termination rights City may terminate with or without cause.
- 7) Indemnity/Insurance Requirements Contractors shall comply with applicable City requirements.
- 8) Scope of Services Weekley Asphalt Paving, Inc. will provide for asphaltic concrete pavement resurfacing in city streets and rights-of-way within the City.
- 9) Other significant provisions The contractor shall guarantee the complete project against poor workmanship and faulty materials for a period of 12 months after final payment and shall immediately correct any defects which may appear during this period upon notification by the City or the Engineer.
