# Mr. Vyacheslav CHERKASOV

## **Professional Accomplishments**

Vyacheslav Cherkasov has been with the United Nations Organization (UN) since 1987. His duties arose from his work as a Research Officer for the UN Institute for Training and Research (UNITAR) where he was engaged in research and technical cooperation activities including organizing forums, round tables of experts, exhibitions and etc in the area of social development polices and planning in response to the priority needs of developing countries. In 1988 Mr. Chrekasov joined the United Nations Secretariat and occupied various high level profession positions in several Departments including the Department of Public Information and Department of Economic and Social Affairs. He organized dozens of celebratory public events of United Nations during his career including the United Nations 60th Anniversary Celebration including development, supervision, monitoring and organizing the successful multi cultural and comprehensive world wide programmed dedicated to the 60th Anniversary of the Organization including special activities, events & projects such as the conference in San Francisco with the theme "Enhancing the Vital Role of the United Nations"; the UN Day programme during MIP TV (broadcasters) market at Cannes attended by 57 media executives representing all major broadcasters from around the world. President Bill Clinton featured as the keynote speaker, live via satellite link from NY Headquarters; an exhibit of historical photographs of the United Nations, sponsored by Hewlett-Packhard; Racism roundtables & a series of "Chronicle conversations" being organized by the UN, Missions, academia and the NGO community to engage in in-house discussions focused on the MDGs; a number of other events were organized New York citywide as part of the celebration of the 60th anniversary, including film festivals, cultural performances, international forums on water and on information technologies, and events for children; prepared press releases, PSAs, briefing materials for SG, USG and other UN senior officials, participated in briefings for media, government and non government

- formulated & implemented the project "Public Information Networking and the Millennium Development Goals (MDGs)" funded by the donor community, and organized the International training workshop on for Cambodia, China, Democratic People's Republic of Korea (DPRK), Mongolia and Vietnam;
- organized & managed the annual UN Day Concerts in 2003 & 2004;
- prepared, monitored & evaluated budgets of the Section, Division, and projects and initiatives;
- arranged the donation from the private sector for production uniforms for the UN Guided tour programme. He undertook and supervised substantive preparations and conducted technical co-operation operational and supervised the Internet Governance Forum Secretariat located in Geneva, Switzerland and participated in organizing annual IGF global events in Kenya, Azerbaijan, Indonesia, Turkey & Brazil. He was the Executive Coordinator of the 7th United Nations Global Forum on Reinventing government. He organized and supervised various public awareness international events such art exhibitions, concerts and performances.
