A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO ISSUE A PURCHASE ORDER TO ALL PAVING INC. FOR ANNUAL SMALL CONCRETE AND PATHWAY CONSTRUCTION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$487,461.00 BASED UPON PALM BEACH COUNTY PROJECT #2020056 IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 38.41(C)(5) OF THE PROCUREMENT CODE (PIGGYBACK).

WHEREAS, the Department of Parks, Recreation and Cultural Arts (“PRCA”) desires to procure pathway work services as multiple pathways need maintenance and renovation; and

WHEREAS, the work being performed will allow park users to continue the use of the parks while addressing standard wear and tear scenarios before they become potential safety concerns; and

WHEREAS, this request will service the following four park locations: Zinkil, Joe DiMaggio, Mara Berman Giuliani and John Williams, and funding is identified through the City’s ongoing capital program and general obligation bond project funding; and

WHEREAS, the desired services were competitively bid through Palm Beach County (“PBC”) Annual Small Concrete and Pathway Construction Contract PBC Project #2020056 on January 28, 2021, and awarded to All Paving, Inc. (“All Paving”); and

WHEREAS, the current term of Annual Small Concrete and Pathway Construction Contract PBC Project #2020056 is from July 13, 2021 through July 12, 2024; and

WHEREAS, All Paving has agreed to extend to the City the same pricing under the terms and conditions set forth in Annual Small Concrete and Pathway Construction Contract PBC Project #2020056; and

WHEREAS, the desired pathway work will be procured for the amount \$487,461.00; and

WHEREAS, Section 38.41(C)(5) of the Procurement Code allows the Chief Procurement Officer to procure, without formal solicitation procedures, all goods, supplies, materials, equipment, and services that are the subject of contracts with the state, its political subdivisions, the United States government, other governmental entities, or a corporation not for profit whose members are governmental entities, public officers, or any combination thereof (“piggyback”), provided that the goods, supplies, materials, equipment, or services

are the subject of a price schedule negotiated by the entities listed above and is based strictly on competitive bids, quotations, or competitive proposals and not on any preference and such utilization of other governmental entities contracts shall be permitted only during the term of the other governmental entity's contract; and

WHEREAS, the Director of PRCA and the Chief Procurement Officer recommend that the City Commission approve and authorize the issuance of the attached Purchase Order to All Paving for pathway work in the amount of \$487,461.00; and

WHEREAS, funding for project was included in the amended FY 2023 Capital Improvement Plan and is available in account numbers

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA.

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.

Section 2: That it approves and authorizes the issuance, by the appropriate City officials, of the attached Purchase Order with All Paving Inc., together with such non-material changes as may subsequently be agreed to by the City Manager and approved as to form and legal sufficiency by the City Attorney.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
