 - b) renewals extensions pursuant to Section 3.7 of the Contract.
 - c) who exercises option to renew City.
- 5) Contract Amount: In the amount of \$469,887.00.
- 6) Termination Rights With or without cause.
- 7) Indemnity/Insurance Requirements Yes.
- 8) Scope of Services: Southeastern Engineering Contractors, Inc. will provide civil work related to the Taft Street Force Main Wall Loss Verification, including maintenance of traffic, excavation, and assistance during the test and site restoration. This project also includes the replacement of a 12 inch diameter PVC water main at the intersection of A1A and Balboa Street and an 8 inch diameter sewer gravity main along North 28th Avenue between Evans Street and Pershing Street.
- 9) Other Significant Provisions: Contract provides for liquidated damages.
