A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING ADDITIONAL SERVICES PROPOSAL NUMBER SEVEN WITH JENKINS AND CHARLAND, INC. A/K/A TRC WORLDWIDE ENGINEERING, TO PROVIDE SPECIAL INSPECTION SERVICES RELATED TO THE FIVE BRIDGES REPAIRS PROJECT, IN AN AMOUNT UP TO \$151,900.00.

WHEREAS, Florida law requires special inspection services for a variety of projects including the bridge repairs proposed for the Johnson Street, Sherman Street, Taft Street, and North 29th Avenue bridges as part of the overall Five Bridges Repairs project ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, on September 1, 2021, the City Commission passed and adopted Resolution Number R-2021-208, approving and authorizing the appropriate City officials to execute Continuing Service Agreements with various firms to provide various engineering services, one of these firms being Jenkins and Charland, Inc. a/k/a TRC Worldwide Engineering ("TRC"); and

WHEREAS, on February 1, 2023, the City Commission approved Resolution Number R-2023-040, authorizing TRC to provide engineering design services for the Project; and

WHEREAS, Additional Services Numbers One, Two, Three, Five, and Six were approved administratively to address additional design services that became necessary during the design of the Project; and

WHEREAS, Additional Services Number Four is currently on hold; and

WHEREAS, during the design phase of the Project, it was determined that special inspections would be required during the construction phase of the Project; and

WHEREAS, special inspections during the construction phase were not included in the original scope of work but is a service that TRC can provide; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Design and Construction Management ("Department" or "DCM") requested a proposal from TRC for additional services to provide special inspections and related services for the Project to allow for the special inspections to proceed for the Johnson Street and Sherman Street Bridge repairs, with optional services for the Taft Street Bridge and North 29th Avenue Bridge once construction funding is available ("Scope of Work"); and

WHEREAS, the Scope of Work for the additional services includes all required special inspection services for the Johnson Street, Sherman Street, Taft Street and North 29th Avenue bridges during the construction phase, as well as related project design services; and

WHEREAS, TRC has provided a proposal, dated October 8, 2025, for special inspection services for the Johnson Street and Sherman Street bridge repairs, required permit extensions, plan revisions due to updated bridge reports, optional services for the Taft Street and North 29th Avenue bridge repairs, and optional services for unforeseen conditions that may necessitate additional inspections in a total amount up to \$151,900.00, which staff has determined to be fair and reasonable and in accordance with industry standards; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to approve these additional services for TRC to provide special inspection services and other services for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Department recommends that the City Commission approve and authorize the execution of Additional Services Proposal Number Seven with TRC for special inspection services for the Johnson Street and Sherman Street bridge repairs, with related services for the Project and optional services for the Taft Street and North 29th Avenue bridge repairs, in an amount up to \$151,900.00; and

WHEREAS, funding for this Project was included in the amended FY 2026 Capital Improvement Plan and is available in account numbers 336.149901.54100.563010.001242.000.000 and 334.179901.54100.563010.001739.000.000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.

Section 2: That it approves and authorizes the appropriate City officials to execute an Additional Services Proposal Number Seven with TRC for an amount up to \$151,900.00, together with such non-material changes as may be subsequently agreed to by the City Manager and approved as to form and legal sufficiency by the City Attorney.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
