FERTILIZER, SITEONE LANDSCAPE SUPPLY LLC, RESIDEX LLC, HELENA CHEMICAL COMPANY, HOWARD FERTILIZER COMPANY, INC., AND HARRELL'S LLC AND THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD FOR THE SUPPLY OF VARIOUS FERTILIZERS AND RELATED CHEMICALS FOR A COMBINED ANNUAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$73,000.00.

Explanation:

This Resolution seeks authorization for the appropriate City Officials to issue a Blanket Purchase Order between the City and the following six (6) vendors: Diamond R. Fertilizer, SiteOne Landscape Supply LLC, Residex LLC, Helena Chemical Company, Howard Fertilizer Company, Inc., and Harrell's LLC for the supply of fertilizers and related chemicals required for turf maintenance and landscaping for an initial three (3) year term commencing on October 15, 2017 and ending on October 14, 2020 with no option to renew, in the combined annual amount not to exceed \$73,000.00.

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The required commodities were competitively bid by the Town of Davie, Florida Bid Number B-17-124, acting as the lead agency for the Southeast Florida Governmental Purchasing Group Cooperative, who awarded contracts to six (6) companies: Diamond R Fertilizer; SiteOne Landscape Supply, LLC; Residex, LLC; Helena Chemical Company; Howard Fertilizer, Inc.; and Harrell's, LLC, for an initial three (3) year period beginning on August 17, 2017 and ending on August 16, 2020, with no options to renew. And, pursuant to Section 38.46 of the City of Hollywood Code of Ordinances, the Director shall have the authority to join with other governmental entities in cooperative purchasing plans when the best interests of the city would be served thereby.

The six purchase orders are written in the following amounts to be utilized by the Department of Public Works in the aggregate amount of \$36,000.00 and the Department of Parks, Recreation and Cultural Arts in the aggregate amount of \$37,000.00 for a combined total of \$73,000.00.
