A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE THE ATTACHED CONTRACT BETWEEN SOUTHEASTERN ENGINEERING CONTRACTORS, INC. AND THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FOR 2017 ALLEY RESURFACING AND RECONSTRUCTION PROGRAM BID NUMBER EN-17-013 AT VARIOUS LOCATIONS IN THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,159,138.40.

WHEREAS, in order to provide for a better overall level of service in alley ways, the City of Hollywood has established funding to reconstruct alleys in the City based on the 2013 Pavement Management Study; and

WHEREAS, specifications for alley resurfacing and reconstruction to implement the 2017 Alley Resurfacing and Reconstruction Program were prepared by the Engineering Division; and

WHEREAS, through receipt of the City's bid specifications for this project, all prospective bidders were provided with a copy of the City's contract, including the terms and conditions contained therein; and

WHEREAS, on March 2, 2017, the 2017 Alley Resurfacing and Reconstruction Program, Project Bid Number EN-17-013, was electronically advertised via BidSync, a Pre-Bid Meeting was held on March 29, 2017, and bid results were received on April 10, 2017 as listed below:

WHEREAS, the bid submitted by Stanford Construction Company did not provide the required bid bond of 10% of the total Bid Price, a bid bond of 5% of the total Bid Price was provided, and therefore was determined to be non-responsive; and

WHEREAS, the bid submitted by Stanford Construction Company was not delivered to the City Clerk's office, it was delivered to the Community Development office and therefore was not publicly opened with the other three bids received; and

WHEREAS, staff has reviewed all submitted bids and determined the bid received from Southeastern Engineering Contractors, Inc. was the lowest responsive and responsible bid, within 10.5% of the engineers estimate and therefore, recommends the award of this contract to Southeastern Engineering Contractors, Inc. in the amount of \$1,159,138.40; and

WHEREAS, award is subject to the City's receipt and approval of all insurance certificates and bonds required by the City's Risk Manager, and indemnity/indemnification to the City; and

WHEREAS, the City may terminate the agreement should the Contractor fail to reasonably perform the services as specified or without cause, upon thirty (30) days written notification; and

WHEREAS, on October 5, 2016 the City Commission adopted R-2016-291, which continued the appropriation for previously approved Capital Projects from FY 16 to FY 17 and included funding for the 2017 Alley Resurfacing and Reconstruction Program; and

WHEREAS, funding is available in account numbers 34.1400.15484.541.006303 and 34.1415.15304.541.006303.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION
THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That it hereby approves and authorizes the execution, by the appropriate City Officials, of the attached contract between Southeastern Engineering Contractors, Inc. and the City of Hollywood, together with such non-material changes, as may be subsequently agreed to by the City Manager and approved as to form and legality by the City Attorney.
