A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING THE ANNUAL PERMIT FEE FOR NEWLY PERMITTED CHARITABLE CLOTHING DONATION BINS AND THE ANNUAL FEE FOR RENEWAL OF PREVIOUSLY PERMITTED CHARITABLE CLOTHING DONATION BINS WITHIN THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD.

## **Explanation:**

This Resolution seeks to establish annual permit fees for charitable clothing donation bins, based on the passage and adoption by the City Commission of Ordinance PO-2014-17 regulating the use and placement of donation bins to be permitted under certain conditions. Upon passage, §109.05(D) of the City of Hollywood Code of Ordinances, Chapter 109: Charitable Clothing Donation Bins requires that fees shall be established and/or amended by Resolution of the City Commission.

The annual permit fee (new or renewal permit), is to be paid at the time of application submission, and will remain effective from October 1 through September 30 of the following year. This Resolution seeks to establish a \$45.00 fee for new permit applications and a \$20.00 fee for renewal permit applications.
