Explanation:

The Department of Public Utilities requires the purchase of a replacement deep well pump for the Deep Injection Well Pump Station at the Southern Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant. This replacement pump is part of a system made up of a total of three pumps and therefore must be replaced with an identical unit.

Flowserve Pumps is the manufacturer of the deep well pump and Carter & Verplanck, Inc. is the sole source is the sole source supplier of the product and service. The City of Hollywood's Purchasing Ordinance 38.40(C)(3) allows sole-source supplies and services, such as unique, patented or franchised supplies or services, to be exempt from the competitive bid requirements.

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Administration recommends issuing a purchase order with Carter & Verplanck, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$125,506.

On October 17, 2012, the City Commission adopted R-2012-336 that approved the FY 2013 Capital Improvement Plan and included the Wastewater Treatment Plant – Maintenance. Funding is available in account #42.4000.85299.536.006302.

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
