Subject: Request for Repayment or Tolling Agreement; Large User Agreement

Dear George:

Thank you for your letter dated April 4, 2024, in which you agreed to tender a tolling agreement to the City Commission for Hollywood with regard to our claim for Repayment. We are asking for one clarification before we respond to your letter. Please confirm whether the tolling agreement would apply to claims to date, or whether you anticipate the application of this tolling agreement to the potential increases in categorical charges (such as the discussion in October of changing the allocation from 18.5 to 22%) arguments. In short, we would like to have a clarification on whether the tolling agreement would apply to disputes concerning the LUA for disputes that existed from True Up annual reports to the time of the tolling agreement. Once we have the clarification, let me know if you are going to bring a specific tolling agreement to the Hollywood City Commission. If so, please tender that agreement so that we can ensure that we are all moving forward as efficiently and expeditiously as possible.

We are willing to continue to remain fully current on our present and future obligations, subject to this one clarification from you so that we understand the full scope of the tolling agreement.
