## Explanation:

The City of Hollywood, Florida ("City") is participating with Broward County, Florida ("County") in the Integrated Water Resources Plan (IWRP) for a 50% cost-sharing grant for landscape irrigation at the Sheridan Street Project.

As part of the IWRP program, it is necessary for the County and the City to enter into an Interlocal Agreement to be recorded in the Public Records of Broward County, Florida.

This project will expand the City's existing reclaimed water system by providing up to 30,000 gallons per day of additional reclaimed water for landscaping.
