ORDINANCE NO. D-89-56

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, VACATING A SECTION OF THE PUBLIC ALLEY BETWEEN TYLER STREET AND HOLLYWOOD BOULEVARD AND WEST OF 20TH AVENUE; SAID PROPERTY BEING MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED HEREIN; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE, A REPEALER CLAUSE AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Advisory Board at its meeting of July 24, 1989, recommended to the City Commission that it vacate certain property more specifically described below; and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration of this matter, including the review of the Growth Management staff report and all submitted written and oral testimony received during the public hearings, the City Commission has determined that the proposed vacation bears a reasonable relation to the health, safety, morals, or welfare of the citizens of Hollywood; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission has determined that the proposed vacation would be in the best interest of the citizens of Hollywood.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the a section of the public alley between Tyler Street and Hollywood Boulevard and West of 20th Avenue, more specifically described in Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, is vacated.

Section 2: That if any word, phrase, clause, subsection or section of this ordinance is for any reason held unconstitutional or invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect the validity of any remaining portions of this ordinance.

Section 3: That all sections or parts of sections of the Code of Municipal Ordinances, all ordinances or parts of ordinances, and all resolutions in conflict herewith, be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.





Pursuant to your memorandum of July 26, 1989, received by this office on August 2, 1989, attached please find a draft of the ordinance in the above-referenced matter for your review. For the purposes of this memorandum "applicant" shall mean the owner or owners of property abutting the publicly dedicated street, alley, waterway or other publicly dedicated place that is the subject of the vacation application.

Kindly verify the accuracy of the legal description of the property to be vacated and further verify whether the applicant has prepared a report on the historical aspects of the publicly dedicated street, alley, waterway or other publicly dedicated place pursuant to Section 17-19(1)(b)(2) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Hollywood.

Moreover, pursuant to the condition imposed by the Planning and Zoning Advisory Board, please have the applicant provide me with a formal letter opinion prepared by an attorney licensed to practice law in the State of Florida opining that (1) the applicant is the fee simple owner of real property abutting a publicly dedicated street, alley, waterway or other publicly dedicated place ("Subject Property") that is the subject of the vacation application and that (2) the applicant has reversionary rights to the Subject Property. I have attached a draft of a sample letter that may be forwarded to the applicant or his/her counsel regarding the letter opinion.

I ask that you include the requirement of a letter opinion as a standard condition in the resolution forwarded to the City Commission memorializing the recommendation of the Planning and Zoning Advisory Board.

Should the ordinance meet with your satisfaction, kindly prepare the appropriate informational memorandum for the City Commission agenda package. Kindly be advised that the ordinance shall not be presented for consideration on the agenda without its accompanying informational memorandum.
