- Develop a master program schedule with milestone tracking using platforms such as Primavera P6 or MS Project, integrated with GIS-based visual reporting.
- Implement centralized financial oversight tools to track budgets, funding source compliance (e.g., grants, bonds), and deliver quarterly financial performance reports.
- Prepare and negotiate clear, well-defined task orders, ensuring scope, deliverables, and costs align with City objectives.
- Use a phased delivery strategy to address urgent interim needs while setting the foundation for long-term capital investments.
- Establish baseline schedules with critical path analysis to monitor progress, manage float, and anticipate delays—enabling data-driven schedule updates and early risk mitigation for projects within the program.

We anticipate **Rashmi Koul** is our Program Controls team to continue to assist with strategic planning and prioritization efforts. Additionally **Bryant Facey**, **PE**, as the Program Planning/Design Manager Lead will assist with strategic planning and prioritization efforts associated with anticipated or future design efforts.

3. Technical and Design Oversight

We will deliver consistency and quality across all stormwater infrastructure projects through:

 Lead the development of City-wide design standards to ensure consistency, scalability, and regulatory compliance.

- Provision of in-house design services for selected projects, including site analysis, hydraulic modeling, and final construction documentation.
- Design oversight of third-party consultants, with QA/QC processes to verify completeness, compliance, and constructability.
- Integration of BIM and GIS tools to support design reviews, utility coordination, and efficient permitting.
- Integrate adaptive design practices and green infrastructure where appropriate to maximize long-term value.

Bryant Facey will also provide leadership, with support from our H&H/stormwater modelers, stormwater conveyance & pipeline, and stormwater pump station engineers and technical staff. This team will work together oversee design projects, provide design reviews, complete preliminary design services, etc. throughout the duration of the program.

4. Funding Strategy and Grant Support Services

- Our research and stakeholder-focused approach to grant application packages helps government agencies and authorities meet their objectives in the face of limited budgets and competitive funding pools, and our ability to provide compliance assistance enables clients to avoid unnecessary delays in funding.
- Our team will provide the right balance of project management to technical services to make certain that each step of the Alternative Grant lifecycle is completed successfully.




Figure E-4. Resource Loaded Schedule and Cash Flow. GFT will use resource management tools throughout the program to manage schedule and budget.

5. Permitting, Procurement, and Construction Management

To provide seamless project delivery, GFT will:

- Prepare technically sound permit applications and respond swiftly to agency comments.
- Support procurement efforts by developing clear RFPs/RFQs, assisting with evaluations and contract negotiations, and ensuring task orders are competitively priced and properly scoped.
- Provide full-service construction management oversight, including review of submittals, RFIs, pay applications, and change orders.
- Implement field documentation protocols, conduct site inspections, and coordinate construction meetings to ensure safety, quality, and progress.

6. Public Outreach and Stakeholder Engagement

GFT understands that public trust is critical to successful program delivery. We acknowledge that the City has embarked on an educational campaign to educate and communicate with its residents about stormwater, water quality, and SLR challenges in the community. Our Program Planning/Design, Construction Management, and Support Staff are anticipated to be involved with permitting, procurement, and construction management tasks. **Martin Benzaquen, PE, ENV SP** will serve as the Construction Program Manager. He has full support from our team of local construction managers, pre-construction surveys & utilities engineering support subconsultants, construction safety, and construction inspectors. We also have permitting support from Keisha Westbrook, PE and Tavares Jackson. Our staff will work together to complete the tasks previously mentioned.



7. Asset Management and Future Planning

- Support the City's asset management strategy by integrating infrastructure data, modeling stormwater scenarios, and informing maintenance planning.
- Develop preventive maintenance templates and capital reinvestment triggers to ensure longterm sustainability of assets.
- Deliver annual CIP updates, adjusting priorities based on data, funding availability, and emerging community needs.

This is a critical leadership role in advancing the City of Hollywood's long-term stormwater resiliency, infrastructure modernization, and sustainable growth. E.4. ABILITY TO SOLVE COMPLEX ISSUES

E.4.1. SLR Adaptation Design Considerations

South Florida is front and center on the effects of sea level rise and its effects in all types of infrastructure projects. Currently South Florida, including the City of Hollywood, is dealing with saltwater intrusion threatening our ground water sources. SLR also affects the life span of underground infrastructure and can attribute to increase in infiltration into sanitary sewer systems, thus affecting the capacity in the sewer system. SLR also impacts the ability for continuing or to maintain or provide adequate stormwater management and drainage of our local neighborhoods roadways in particular low laying areas into the future.

These issues will exacerbate the need for resilient infrastructure to continue to provide the level of service for South Florida residents and the City will have to incorporate infrastructure solutions to mitigate some impacts at the local level of responsibility. We understand that the solution is not for the City alone to tackle, but that the adaptation of these challenges will have to be in collaboration with agencies such as SFWMD, USACE, FEMA, FDOT, and other stakeholders. We are already working with local and State agencies on identifying and implementing infrastructure to mitigate future conditions.

E.4.2. Construction Considerations



For the Miami Dade DTPW, the team is designing the Lake Belmar Stormwater pump station within a coastal neighborhood in North Miami to provide pumping capacity to alleviate current and future stormwater runoff. The site also presents challenges due to the constraint space where this facility will be located.

E.5.1. InfoWater/InfoSWMM

GFT has comprehensive experience with industrystandard computer software for modeling distribution systems, transmission systems, gravity sewers, stormwater and drainage systems. We currently hold full suite licenses for multiple modeling software including Innovyze (an Autodesk company) InfoSWMM, InfoWorks CS, InfoWater and others. The selection of the modeling tool will depend on project requirements and/or our client preferences.

For water distribution modeling and management, we have used InfoWater modeling software, which is fully integrated with the Esri ArcGIS® platform. InfoWater can be used to perform comprehensive hydraulic analyses for effective, economical selection and sizing of water distribution piping and appurtenances, achieve adequate pressure and flow in the system, and fire flow protection requirements.

We applied InfoWater modeling for evaluation, prioritization, and validation of design requirements on our Allentown Division System Water Main Replacement for Lehigh County Authority, where our team managed and designed approximately 20 miles of water main replacement of unlined cast iron pipe over a period 8 years.

Other projects include Virginia American Water's Alexandria and Hopewell District Water Main Replacement where InfoWater was used to determine water main sizes and fire flow coverage and capacity evaluations. Additionally, our team has in-depth experience using InfoSWMM modeling tool for evaluating backflow, surcharge, and overflow analysis for determining performance of sanitary sewer systems. Additionally InfoSWMM is a powerful modeling tool for evaluating drainage systems providing analysis for the planning and management of stormwater networks.

E.5.2. CFD Modeling

With a comprehensive, expert-level understanding of hydraulics, GFT's experienced and talented hydraulic engineers are problem-solvers, using advanced and highly-detailed 3D CFD models to perform analyses leading to a more thorough understanding of the hydraulics and designs,




Figure E-6. CFD Model. GFT completed a CFD model for SFWMD's S-426 Pump Station.

resulting in significant cost savings to our clients. Additionally, we have a successful history teaming with a hydraulics laboratories that aid in our pump station designs by providing physical models to better determine project elements that may affect pump performance, allowing us to provide recommendations for design revisions that could potentially provide cost savings and improve operations for our clients.

E.5.3. Stormwater Modeling

GFT team has vast experience in the analysis and design of stormwater systems for different types of roadway and infrastructure projects. Our team uses several stormwater analysis programs, including Geo-Hec-Ras, ASAD, Arc-GIS, Mike-She, Mike-11, XPSWMM, and ICPR V4 1D/2D with the capabilities of ArcGIS integration to provide a more thorough analysis and design.

E.5.4. BIM Integration

We will assign design projects that require the preparation of drawings a CAD/BIM coordinator responsible for setting up the design production requirements. This person will prepare a Project Information Management Plan delineating design execution based on the platform used. The CAD/BIM coordinator is also responsible for managing access, attributes, and updates of the Autodesk Collaborate Pro collaboration platform. We have extensive experience working with Autodesk and serve as a technical advisor to their Water Advisory Council for industry guidance and leadership.

The GFT team has members in the Autodesk Expert Elite program, where users are recognized for their contributions to the software community and provide instructors to Autodesk University. Our engineering technology division support every design team to from planning, setup and execution of BIM models in Autodesk platforms.

For the City of Hollywood, we proposed design platforms including Revit, Inventor, AutoCAD Plant 3D, Civil 3D, AutoCAD MEP, Autodesk BIM 360 online tools, providing realistic representations of a project at each stage of project and encouraging innovation and collaboration throughout its lifecycle. We will continue to comply with your deliverable requirements in the AutoCAD format anticipated by the City. These design tools are standard to produce efficient drainage utility, pump stations, or other stormwater facilities.

E.5.5 GIS

GFT is an Esri® Release Ready Platinum Partner and has experience implementing indepth location analytics, utility network, and adding robust asset management systems can dramatically increase the value of your operations. For utility projects, we use Esri's ArcGIS Utility Network is a GIS for water distribution systems that displays the components that make up a utility in a detailed yet simple-to-understand interactive visual. For water distribution systems, these components would include mains, valves, pressure zones, fittings, and other field assets. The ArcGIS Utility Network also allows to build realworld behavior into the features you model. It can take complex structures such as pump stations and backflow systems and show them as a single unit, or it can open them up to view all the detailed assets within.

E.5.6. Notify

GeoDecisions, GFT's geospatial division, has decades of experience developing innovative solutions for local, state, federal, and private clients. One of the premier products GeoDecisions has developed, Notify, was built initially for the water industry. Notify is an advanced, high-speed alert notification system designed to deliver mass voice, text, and email messages to utilities, businesses, communities, and schools within

minutes. It is flexible enough to be used as the primary customer and employee communications platform for your organization. This web-based solution leverages your organization's existing customers, employees, and GIS mapping information to distribute critical information during an emergency quickly and securely. Combining Notify and Utility Network allows users to identify or isolate the clients impacted by a water main break or other issue. Notify will send text, email, or voice messages within minutes to these clients to provide additional information or directions. In addition to Notify, GeoDecisions has developed several other custom applications and products including field collection tools, dashboards, a vehicle tracking application (Track) and GeoPlan.

E.5.7. Cybersecurity

GFT's Security and Safety business line was founded in 2005 to serve all of the critical infrastructure markets that GFT supports. From a staff of two to now more than 30 professional security and safety personnel, our team's vision is to be a driving force in improving the security, safety, emergency preparedness and resiliency of our clients, communities, and their supporting infrastructure. We can provide a detailed understanding of the City's compliance to the industry standards for cybersecurity, and help streamline their system so that it remains consistent, repeatable, and defendable, allowing the City to be confident in understanding the cybersecurity risks to your system.

E.5.8. Drone Evaluation and Inspection

GFT has implemented drone technology on more than 100 projects, helping us to minimize inspection hours. We are using drones on some of our on-going projects with FDOT in South Florida. Drones can inspect areas with difficult access and conduct vertical inspection where there are safety concerns. We also use drones with LiDAR technology to track field quantities, conduct land surveys, and collect data for as-built and post-construction asset management programs.

E.5.9. Virtual Reality (VR) and Augmented Reality (AR)

Virtual and augmented reality is integral to some of our major construction projects. We recently implemented VR technology on a large facility project in northern Virginia, where we performed constructability reviews during design. The owner/ operators were able to tour the facility in VR, which allowed them to identify potential conflicts with equipment operability. We have also been piloting augmented reality hardware on our design and construction projects. Our field inspectors use iPad cameras to capture a composite view of the real word overlaid with the 2D or 3xD design, which helps them quickly identify work that is out of compliance and/or admissible for punchlist development. Our inspectors are equipped with tablets that can support BIM 360 models, and the

3D views allow both the inspector and contractor to easily identify and articulate potential conflicts with the designers.

E.5.10. 360 Cameras and Time-Lapsed Videos

Using 360 cameras on linear projects to document site conditions during preconstruction surveys allows us to thoroughly evaluate site conditions and provide accurate data for claim reviews. 360 scanners on facility projects (with unavailable as-builts) document dimensions and proximity of objects to create accurate as-built conditions. Data is more readily available with time-lapsed videos when compared to tracking daily work reports, which helps us efficiently track contractors' down time during claim and change-orders evaluation associated with time extension request.

E.6. PROPOSED SCHEDULING METHODOLOGY

For tasks assigned, our team will prepare and submit for review and approval, a project management control schedule, in Gantt Chart format, using MS Project software which will incorporate all the work elements defined in the negotiated contract documents. The draft schedule will include all tasks and milestones necessary to provide an approved Bid-Ready Package, including








Figure E-8. VR/AR. Reality capture is integral to some of our major construction projects.

the necessary permits, by the date to be specified by the City. We will submit the schedule to the City's Project Manager promptly on notice to proceed (NTP). The schedule will be maintained on interactive eBuilder Microsoft Project Scheduler. Allowances for City review will also be included as determined in final contract negotiations.

E.6.1. Respond Quickly to Task Assignments

Smaller task order assignments must often be addressed quickly and efficiently—particularly when they are in response to emergency or urgent requests. This is not an uncommon occurrence for us. Our clients often use us as an extension of staff, and clients also use us for urgent needs. The task is initiated with a simple purchase order type of contract.

On some task order agreements, we include contingency "un-opened" tasks to be used to address urgent tasks without the need for additional paperwork. Owner risk is minimal because these tasks are typically of short duration where little budget can be expended.

E.6.2. Ability to Complete Tasks on Accelerated Schedules

GFT can reach hundreds of employees with water utility experience at all levels: from planning to CAD design details. Our Program Leads, with decades of municipal utility experience, have experience with tasks requiring accelerated schedules. Our schedule tracking process allows us to evaluate whether we are performing on time and if we need to make any adjustments to rectify any instances when we are not meeting

schedule requirements. Additionally, if warranted and feasible, we can embed staff in the City. This will reduce costs, improve communications and accessibility, and truly extend your staff.

E.7. APPROACH TO SCALABILITY

Our staff has become adept at understanding and implementing multiple concurrent projects while meeting our clients' unique needs. We typically structure our continuing service contract teams to include several Task Leads, so we can undertake multiple task orders concurrently. We are extraordinarily successful in serving our many and varied clients through this method of service delivery by bringing leadership and comprehensive resources to each assignment. We understand the significant coordination needed on these types of contracts with the various entities and key stakeholders. Our knowledge and understanding will guide our design and construction approach to achieve clear and effective coordination and gain support from all affected parties to enhance the likelihood of a successful project outcome that meets the program schedule.

So we can effectively manage and complete multiple concurrent task orders, GFT will identify Task Leads for each assigned work order. These individuals can use the support staff to perform services under each task order assignment. We can also provide efficiency during task order execution. On previous similar contracts, we have minimized project start-up time by assigning similar task managers, discussing several task orders at one kick-off or progress meeting, and using experienced team members with similar project knowledge and experience. KNOWLEDGE OF SITE AND LOCAL CONDITIONS

F.1. KNOWLEDGE OF SITE, REQUIREMENTS, CODES, AND ORDINANCES

Gannett Fleming, Inc. (now known as GFT Infrastructure, Inc.) brings in-depth familiarity with local codes, ordinances, permitting processes, and site-specific requirements that will directly inform the successful execution of stormwater projects across all phases of the program.

As PgM, we will endeavor for every project—whether a long-term capital improvement, urgent interim task, or renewal and replacement effort— to comply with the City of Hollywood Code of Ordinances Chapter 54, which governs the City's Stormwater Utility. This chapter sets the foundation for stormwater system operation, funding, and maintenance, and aligns directly with the SWMP's goals of reducing flooding, improving water quality, and building long-term resilience.

Our team is fluent in the City's Land Development Regulations (LDRs), including Article VII – Site Development Standards, which establish minimum criteria for stormwater infrastructure design, such as retention requirements, system sizing, and elevation thresholds. These standards are critical to managing the program's portfolio of projects in areas with high groundwater tables, and coastal exposure—such as the Hollywood Lakes, South Lake, and Boulevard Heights neighborhoods.

As the City's representative, GFT will oversee design consistency and permitting compliance across all task orders. This includes verifying projects align with the City of Hollywood Engineering Design Standards and Specifications Manual, as well as with Broward County Ordinance Chapter 27, Article V governing surface water management. Where feasible, we will integrate LID features such as swales, pervious surfaces, and recharge systems to complement the City's NPDES permit and TMDL compliance strategies.

During construction management, GFT enforces compliance with erosion and sedimentation controls under Chapter 151 and construction activity regulations in Chapter 100, ensuring that all field activities align with the City's expectations for safety, environmental protection, and public communication. Our internal QA/QC processes and field protocols will verify that infrastructure is delivered in accordance with the City's restoration and inspection standards and is eligible for acceptance and long-term.

F.2. EXPERIENCE WORKING IN LOCAL AREAS

GFT has extensive experience delivering complex infrastructure projects in South Florida's low-elevation, hurricane-prone environments, where storm surge, SLR, high groundwater levels, and extreme wind forces must be addressed through every phase of planning, design, permitting, and construction.

Our team is deeply familiar with the unique environmental, geotechnical, and regulatory challenges that shape infrastructure delivery in these sensitive coastal regions.

Our work spans multiple municipalities and counties, including the City of Hollywood, Miami-Dade County, Broward County, North Bay Village, and the City of North Miami, and many more beyond South Florida and throughout the eastern United States and includes stormwater pump stations, large-diameter culverts, regional drainage upgrades, and wastewater treatment infrastructure—all designed with an emphasis on resilience and regulatory compliance.

For example, GFT led the engineering, permitting, and construction support for a stormwater pump stations in the Lake Belmar neighborhood of Miami-Dade County and for North Bay Village,

both areas highly vulnerable to coastal flooding and storm surge. The project involved:

- Elevated design of all critical infrastructure including control panels, generators, and fuel storage—above Category 5 hurricane surge levels
- An energy-dissipating outfall structure and new seawall at Biscayne Bay to prevent shoreline erosion
- Integration of a multi-stage filtration system to reduce nutrient loading from stormwater runoff into the Bay
- Coordination with key regulatory agencies including USACE, SFWMD, and Miami-Dade Building Department

In the City of Hollywood, GFT provided full design lifecycle services for a critical stormwater culvert installation on Johnson Street, enhancing flood protection and connectivity between FDOT and City stormwater systems. The culvert was hydraulically modeled for 83 cfs under a 10-year storm event, carefully designed to pass beneath existing utilities and integrated with reinforced concrete end structures. This location, adjacent to flood-prone swales and low-lying parklands, requires close coordination with FDOT and City agencies to ensure long-term functionality under extreme rainfall and high groundwater conditions.

Additionally, GFT plays a vital role in MDWASD's major infrastructure programs:

- As part of the OOL Program, we managed design and construction support for the NE-1 75 mgd Injection Wells and Pump Station, located in a coastal flood zone and requiring detailed planning for flood protection, stormwater systems, and municipal permitting
- Under the CD Program, GFT has led program management, permitting oversight, QA/QC, and engineering review for collection system and treatment facility upgrades in high-risk flood and hurricane impact zones

In Hollywood, stormwater projects typically require coordination with the City's Department of Public Utilities, as well as external agencies such as Broward County Environmental Engineering and Permitting Division, SFWMD, and in some cases FDEP. We understand the County's delegation agreement with SFWMD, which requires Environmental Resource Permits (ERP) for projects with significant land disturbance or impervious surface area. Additionally, we are well-versed in the Broward County Surface Water Management Licensing Program, which mandates permits for any construction activity that alters natural surface water flow.

Our team is familiar with the Environmental Review Approval (ERA) process required prior to the issuance of building permits and has successfully supported clients through conceptual permit applications for system-wide stormwater improvements, followed by phased construction and operational permits.

Equally important, we have in-depth knowledge of the testing standards and inspection protocols necessary for stormwater infrastructure in Hollywood. This includes conformance with FDOT and Broward County stormwater design criteria, adherence to standard operating procedures for pipe, structure, and outfall inspections, and coordination of as-built surveys, CCTV inspections, and post-construction hydrologic testing as required for permit closeout and system acceptance.

F.4. EXPERIENCE WORKING WITH COMPLEX LOGISTICAL CHALLENGES

GFT's experience in delivering programs and infrastructure projects in densely developed urban areas and sensitive environments, where public safety, coordination with occupied facilities, and stringent safety protocols are paramount. In the City of Hollywood, our work on the Johnson Street Stormwater Culvert Installation required careful coordination across multiple public-facing and utility-impacted corridors. The installation of a 140 LF reinforced concrete culvert beneath an active roadway—surrounded by residential neighborhoods, FDOT infrastructure, and public parklands—demanded constructability evaluations, and careful traffic control coordination to provide uninterrupted public access and mitigate risk, our team developed and supported:

- Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) plans
- Utility coordination and protection strategies
- Construction sequencing to limit roadway closures
- Installation of standby power systems and elevated equipment to preserve operation during storm events while maintaining safe access for crews and emergency responders
- Supporting stakeholder communications and public meetings to discuss project impacts and mitigation strategies

As part of the MDWASD OOL and CD Programs, GFT has worked on multiple infrastructure upgrades at active wastewater treatment facilities. These projects require:






