SUBJECT: Proposed Authorization to Proceed for Brown & Caldwell

I have discussed the above Agreement with the participating Department/Office, and the proposed general business terms and other significant provisions are as follows:

- 1) Department/Division involved – Public Utilities
 - 2) Type of Agreement – Work Order B&C 14-02
 - 3) Method of Procurement (RFP, bid, etc.) – Per Florida Statute 287.055, Consultants' Competitive Negotiation Act
 - 4) Term of Contract
 - a) initial – 210 calendar days
 - b) renewals (if any) – n/a
 - c) who exercises option to renew – n/a
 - 5) Contract Amount – \$64,059.00
 - 6) Termination rights – Either party may terminate for cause. City may terminate for convenience.
 - 7) Indemnity/Insurance Requirements – Consultant shall comply with applicable City requirements.
 - 8) Scope of Services – Contractor shall provide professional engineering services to assist with updates to the City's 2008 Water Supply Work Plan.
 - 9) Other significant provisions – n/a
