A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS BUDGETS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2015 ADOPTED BUDGET (R-2014-282), APPROVING THE ROLLOVER OF CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$8,654,814.00, PREVIOUSLY APPROVED AND AVAILABLE AT THE END OF FISCAL YEAR 2014 TO FISCAL YEAR 2015 FOR CAPITAL PROJECTS AS SET FORTH IN EXHIBITS A, AND REVISING OPERATING REVENUES, AUTHORIZING BUDGETARY TRANSFERS, REAUTHORIZING AND RE-APPROPRIATING CERTAIN FUNDING, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, at the end of FY 2014, there were obligated but unexpended Capital Improvement Plan funds; and

WHEREAS, certain routine and periodic budgetary adjustments and transfers are appropriate and necessary; and

WHEREAS, operational requirements necessitate certain revisions to the Adopted Fiscal Year 2015 Budget to promote greater productivity, effectiveness, and efficiency; and

WHEREAS, Exhibit A represents funds available for rollover for General Debt Financing funded capital projects and Gas Tax funded capital projects and various financing of City Wide capital projects at FY 2014 year end;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

<u>Section 1:</u> That these Amendments to the Capital Budget of the City of Hollywood for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2014, and set forth in detail in Exhibits A, attached hereto, and by this reference made a part hereof, are hereby approved, adopted and authorized as Amendments to the Capital Improvement Projects Budget of the City of Hollywood Florida, for the Fiscal Year 2015.

<u>Section 2</u>: That the rollover of previously approved and available capital improvement plan funds as of the end of FY 2014 is hereby approved.
