A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO ISSUE A PURCHASE ORDER TO EMERGENCY VEHICLES, INC. FOR THE UPFITTING OF A MOBILE COMMAND VEHICLE IN AN AMOUNT UP TO \$110,720.00 BASED UPON CONTRACT NUMBER FS12-23: FIRE APPARATUS AND RELATED VEHICLES IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 38.41(C)(5) OF THE PROCUREMENT CODE. (PIGGYBACK)

WHEREAS, the Police Department desires to upfit a mobile command vehicle to support the management of incidents and planned events by providing interior and exterior workspaces; and

WHEREAS, mobile command vehicle upfitting was competitively bid by the Houston-Galveston Area Council through RFP Number FS12-23 for Fire Apparatus and Related Vehicles on July 26, 2023 and awarded to Emergency Vehicles, Inc. under Contract Number FS12-23: Fire Apparatus and Related Vehicles ("Contract"); and

WHEREAS, the current term of the Contract is from December 1, 2023 through November 30, 2027; and

WHEREAS, Emergency Vehicles, Inc. has agreed to extend to the City the same pricing under the terms and conditions set forth in the Contract; and

WHEREAS, the period of performance during which the mobile command vehicle upfitting will be acquired is over a one-year period for an annual amount up to \$110,720.00; and

WHEREAS, Section 38.41(C)(5) of the Procurement Code allows the Chief Procurement Officer to procure, without formal solicitation procedures, all goods, supplies, materials, equipment, and services that are the subject of contracts with the state, its political subdivisions, the United States government, other governmental entities, or a corporation not for profit whose members are governmental entities, public officers, or any combination thereof ("piggyback"), provided that the goods, supplies, materials, equipment, or services are the subject of a price schedule negotiated by the entities listed above and is based strictly on competitive bids, quotations, or competitive proposals and not on any preference and such utilization of other governmental entities contracts shall be permitted only during the term of the other governmental entity's contract; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police and Chief Procurement Officer recommend that the City Commission authorize the issuance of a Purchase Order to Emergency Vehicles, Inc. for upfitting of a mobile command vehicle in an amount up to \$110,720.00; and

WHEREAS, funding for the Purchase Order was included in the amended FY 2024 Capital Improvement Plan, and is available in account number 557.209901.52100.564520.000000.000.000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA.

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.

Section 2: That it authorizes the issuance, by the appropriate City officials, of a Purchase Order to Emergency Vehicles, Inc., together with such non-material changes as may subsequently be agreed to by the City Manager and approved as to form by the City Attorney.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
