Explanation:

This Resolution seeks authorization for the appropriate City Officials to issue a purchase order to Quantum Measurements Corporation from the City of Hollywood for the sale and delivery of four (4) Metrix Setpoint Machinery Protection Systems for Influent Pumps 1 and 5 at the Wastewater Treatment Plant. Previously as a result of a problem with one of the influent pumps at the Wastewater Treatment Plant, the Metrix Setpoint vibration and temperature monitoring system was damaged and requires replacement of the Metrix Setpoint System and various sensors. The Metrix Setpoint Systems are sold exclusively by Quantum Measurements Corporation as the authorized representative of the manufacturer of the Metrix Setpoint Systems. The City desires to purchase four (4) Metrix Setpoint Systems with associated sensors costing a total of \$86,564.00 for the four systems.

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The City's Purchasing Ordinance at §38.40(C)(3) exempts sole source supplies and services, such as unique, patented or franchised supplies or services, from the competitive bid requirements. Funding for the purchase of the four Metrix Setpoint Systems will become available in account #42.4000.85299.536.006302 subject to the approval of the Resolution scheduled for the November 18th City Commission agenda approving the FY 15 to FY 16 capital projects funding rollovers.

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
