Explanation:

This Resolution authorizes a statement of work with CBRE, Inc. for various professional real estate services related to 4 city owned properties. The services to be provided include due diligence, visioning and planning, market engagement, proposal evaluation and post transaction services.

The City's initial cost for these services is a \$7,500 monthly retainer. The anticipated time period for services to be provided is 12 - 15 months for a total estimated cost of \$90,000 to \$112,500. Additionally, a market fee will be charged by CBRE to the prospective Developer. If CBRE is able to successfully close on a property and the market fee is paid by the Developer, then the City would receive a credit for previous monthly retainers paid.

The not to exceed amount of \$130,000 enables the City to request additional services from CBRE such as architectural and engineering, space programming, employment experts, traffic consultants, tax specialists, land planners/architects and parking consultants.
