Tapered Lay-out.

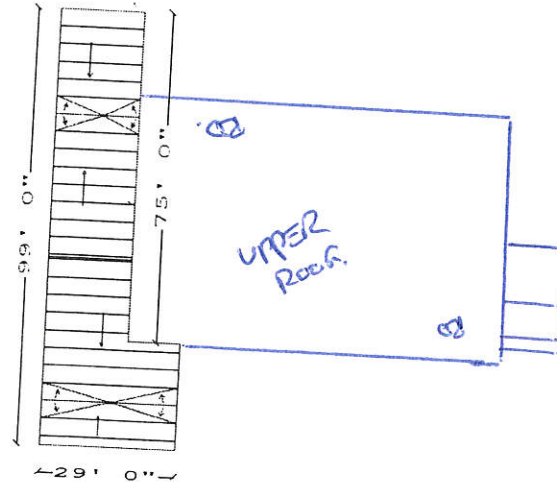



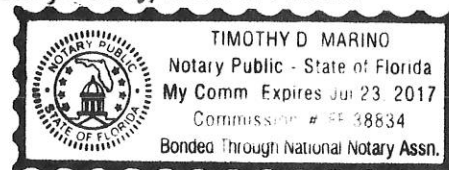
