

RESOLUTION NO. R-2014-076

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE THE ATTACHED AMENDMENT TO THE MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT BETWEEN MOTOROLA SOLUTIONS, INC, AND THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD TO DELETE THE MAINTENANCE COSTS FOR THE OLDER RADIOS AND RELATED HARDWARE.

WHEREAS, upon the City joining the Broward County Regional Communications Network in December, 2003, the City Commission authorized and executed an agreement for the financing and acquisition of Motorola radios and accessories; and

WHEREAS, on October 2, 2013, the City Commission passed and adopted Resolution No. R-2013-281 which approved an annual maintenance agreement with Motorola Solutions Inc. for the Motorola radios, software and related licenses; and

WHEREAS, on December 18, 2013, the City Commission passed and adopted Resolution R-2013-368, which authorized the appropriate City Officials to execute an agreement with Motorola Solutions, Inc. for the acquisition and financing of new radios and related accessories which included three years of maintenance; and

WHEREAS, in consideration of the acquisition and deployment of the new radios, Motorola Solutions Inc. has agreed to amend the October 2, 2013 agreement to delete the maintenance costs for the older radios effective March 1, 2014;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That it hereby approves and authorizes the execution, by the appropriate City Officials, of the attached amendment to the October 2, 2013 agreement between Motorola Solutions, Inc. and the City of Hollywood, together with such non-material changes as may be subsequently agreed to by the City Manager and approved as to form and legality by the City Attorney.

**Amendment to that certain Service Agreement dated October 1, 2013 by and between Motorola, Inc. (Lessor) and the City of Hollywood (Lessee).**

THIS AMENDMENT to that certain October 1, 2013 Service Agreement is dated effective March 1, 2014 (the "Effective Date") and is agreed to between the City of Hollywood, Florida ("City") and Motorola Solutions, Inc. (f/k/a Motorola, Inc.). It is mutually covenanted and agreed by and between the parties hereto that said Agreement is amended upon the terms, covenants, and conditions hereinafter set forth.

1. That the term of the Service Agreement is hereby as set forth in the Amended Service Agreement Order which sets forth a new service schedule for existing radio equipment owned by the City.
2. That effective March 1, 2014, Motorola shall no longer provide maintenance services to the City with regard to the existing radio equipment and the maintenance costs in the amount of \$104,347.04 shall no longer be in effect and shall cease to be charged to the City.
3. That Motorola shall provide Fire Alerting, hardware and software services related to the City's existing radio equipment and system pursuant to the attached Service Agreement dated October 1, 2013 and this Amendment, as more specifically set forth in the Amended Service Agreement Order #0555023480613, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.
4. That all other terms, provisions and conditions of the October 1, 2013 Service Agreement shall be and remain the same and in full force and effect.
