R-2014-136 TO CLARIFY THAT THE FUNDING SOURCE FOR THE PURCHASE OF THE ARMORED VEHICLE FROM LENCO INDUSTRIES, INC. D/B/A LENCO ARMORED VEHICLES WILL BE FROM FEDERAL LAW ENFORCEMENT FUNDS PURSUANT TO THE FEDERAL COMPREHENSIVE CRIME CONTROL ACT.

Explanation:

Previously, the City Commission via Resolution R-2014-136, adopted and approved on June 4, 2014, approved and authorized the issuance of a purchase order from the City of Hollywood to Lenco Armored Vehicles for the purchase of an armored vehicle for the use of the Police Department. This Resolution incorrectly stated that State Law Enforcement Funds, as authorized through the Florida Contraband Forfeiture Act, were available for the purchase of the armored vehicle. The actual source of funding is Federal Law Enforcement Funds. Consequently, this resolution restates the correct source of funding for the purchase of the armored vehicle as Federal Law Enforcement Funds, as authorized through the Federal Comprehensive Crime Control Act. There is no change to the amount of funding, \$268,956.00, authorized for the purchase of the armored vehicle.
