A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, AMENDING RESOLUTION NOS. R-2010-171, R-2011-303 AND R-2016-184 IN ORDER TO ESTABLISH ON-STREET PARKING RATES WITHIN DOWNTOWN HOLLYWOOD; AND AMENDING R-2011-303 TO ELIMINATE THE THREE HOUR FREE ON-STREET PARKING PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, on June 16, 2010, the City Commission passed and adopted Resolution No. R-2010-171 which established fees for parking permits, valet permits, on-street parking, and garage parking, and created a one year pilot program to promote alternative fuel/hybrid vehicles by allowing them free parking in metered spaces on the street; and

WHEREAS, on October 19, 2011, the City Commission passed and adopted Resolution No. R-2011-303, which amended Resolution R-2010-171, to authorize free surface parking in the downtown, discontinue the first two-hour free program in the two city-owned parking garages, and establishes rates for the downtown parking garages; and

WHEREAS, on June 15, 2016, the City Commission passed and adopted R-2016-184, which amended Resolution R-2010-171, in order to establish specific fees for on-street parking, surface lot parking, garage parking, and special event parking on Hollywood Beach; and

WHEREAS, on May 17, 2017, the City Commission expressed a desire to reestablish paid parking in the downtown area and eliminate the three hour free on-street parking program; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission discussed conditions of the parking program, including paid on-street parking in the downtown area (boundaries: west – Dixie Highway, east -17th Avenue, south - Washington Street, north – Taylor Street), with no limit and enforced 24 hours per day every day, and the establishment of a \$1.50 an hour rate; and

WHEREAS, implementation will require an amendment to the previous resolutions, specifically Exhibit “C” attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That it hereby amends Section 3 of Resolution R-2011-303 to eliminate the three hour free on-street surface parking in parking spaces in the downtown area (boundaries: west - Dixie Highway, east - 17th Avenue, south - Washington Street, north – Taylor Street),

Section 2: That it hereby amends Exhibit “C” of Resolution Nos. R-2010-171, R-2011-303 and R-2016-184 as it relates to Metered Street and Lot Parking Rates for the Downtown area, as more specifically set forth in the attached Exhibit “C”.

Section 3: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and adoption.

NOTATION: In order to receive the Hollywood Resident Rate, Hollywood Residents must register their vehicle with the Office of Parking and enroll in the City's pay by mobile phone program. Proof of residency and annual registration with the Office of Parking are required.

Three Required Documents to Prove Residency:

1. Valid photo ID issued by local, state or federal agency (driver's license, passport); and
2. Valid vehicle registration belonging to the person applying for the resident rate; and
3. Current utility bill such as electric, gas, cable or phone which matches the resident's name and address. The current statement must have been mailed within the last 30 days.
