A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, APPOINTING FOUR MEMBERS TO THE EDUCATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE.

WHEREAS, on March 21, 2001, the City Commission passed and adopted Resolution R-2001-93 establishing the Education Advisory Committee ("Committee"); and

WHEREAS, R-2001-93 was subsequently amended by Resolutions R-2002-241, R-2003-144, R-2003-373, R-2004-203, R-2005-299, R-2007-421, R-2009-188, R-2011-143, R-2012-186, R-2013-088, R-2015-262, R-2018-176, R-2023-175, and R-2024-221 establishing the current composition of the Committee as four Teacher Members, seven Regular Members, and two Student Alternate Members; and

WHEREAS, members of the Committee must reside, work or attend public school in Hollywood and be recognized for their broad countywide interest in education; and

WHEREAS, persons of diverse perspectives shall be represented on the Committee, including parents of pre-school or school-age children, educators, businesspeople, and persons with child development or education-related backgrounds; and

WHEREAS, there are three vacant Regular Member positions with terms ending June 30, 2026, June 30, 2027, and June 30, 2028, due to the declination of appointment by Adam Roberti, the removal of Dr. Mary Mites-Campbell, and the resignation of Valorie Weldon; and

WHEREAS, there is a vacant Student Alternate Member position with a term expiring on June 30, 2028; and

WHEREAS, the City Clerk provided notice to the public that positions are available on the Committee and solicited interest forms from citizens to fill available vacancies; and

WHEREAS, the following candidates have expressed interest and are qualified for appointments to the Committee as a Regular Member:

WHEREAS, the following candidate has expressed an interest and is qualified for appointment to the Committee as a Student Alternate Member:

Brooke Manasse (re-appointment)

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.
Section 2: That the following individuals are appointed to the Education Advisory Committee as:
 That is appointed as a Regular Member, whose term expires on June 30, 2026.
 That is appointed as a Regular Member, whose term expires on June 30, 2027.
3. That is appointed as a Regular Member, whose term expires on June 30, 2028.
 That is appointed as a Student Alternate, whose term expires on June 30, 2028.
