A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT AND SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE SEPTEMBER 1, 2012 INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH BROWARD COUNTY FOR SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL SUPPORT SERVICES FOR A PARTICIPATING COMMUNITY JOINING AFTER JULY 3, 2023, FOR THE PERIOD FROM OCTOBER 1, 2024 THROUGH JULY 2, 2028.

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works is responsible for the disposal of waste and waste services, which required an agreement with a qualified contractor to provide solid waste disposal services Citywide; and

WHEREAS, in June 2012, Broward County entered into an agreement with Wheelabrator Environmental Systems Inc., ("Wheelabrator") to provide for the disposal of solid waste generated within Broward County; and

WHEREAS, on September 1, 2012, Broward County and various municipalities within the county entered an Interlocal Agreement for Solid Waste Disposal Support Services ("Interlocal Agreement"), which was later amended by a First Amendment, allowing each Participating Community to select Wheelabrator for waste disposal services and now, the City will be included in the Interlocal Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City was invited to join through a Second Amendment to the September 1, 2012 Interlocal Agreement for a Participating Community joining after July 3, 2023, and is renewed through July 2, 2028; and

WHEREAS, by participating in the Interlocal Agreement, the City will be responsible for the collection, transport, delivery and deposit of all the following waste: Yard Waste, Bulk Trash, Construction and Demolition Debris, Municipal Solid Waste ("MSW") and Recyclables, at the following rates:

Residential MSW \$56.15 per ton Commercial MSW \$101.15 per ton Bulk/C&D \$56.15 per ton

; and

WHEREAS, the City, as a Participating Community, acknowledges that the transportation portion of the Post-2023 Participant Disposal Services Fee is based upon Participating Community information regarding the composition and volume of Participating Community's Residential Waste and Commercial Waste, which is estimated to be

approximately \$3,375,000.00 per year at the time of execution but may fluctuate for each remaining year of the Renewal Period; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works desires to enter into the Interlocal Agreement in an annual amount up to \$3,375,000.00 over a four-year renewal period; and

WHEREAS, Section 38.49(C)(1) of the Procurement Code states that when a contract entered into by the City pursuant to City Commission approval provides for one or more renewals by affirmative action of the City, and the estimated annual cost of a renewal exceeds \$250,000.00, only the City Commission is authorized to approve such renewals, which includes this desired renewal; and

WHEREAS, the Director of the Department of Public Works recommends that the City Commission authorize the execution of the Interlocal Agreement for Solid Waste Disposal Support Services for Participating Community joining after July 3, 2023 in an annual amount of \$3,375,000.00; and

WHEREAS, a portion of the funding for the Interlocal Agreement is available in the FY 2025 Operating Budget in account numbers 445.520102.53400.534980.000000.0000, 445.520101.53400.543610.000000.0000, and 445.520101.53400.543600.000000.0000, and will be budgeted in subsequent fiscal years' operating budget subject to approval and adoption by the City Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA.

<u>Section 1</u>: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated in this Resolution.

Section 2: That it approves and authorizes the execution, by the appropriate City officials, of the Interlocal Agreement with Broward County and Participating Communities for Solid Waste Disposal Support Services, together with such non-material changes as may subsequently be agreed to by the City Manager and approved as to form by the City Attorney.

Section 3: That it approves and authorizes the execution, by the appropriate City officials, of the Second Amendment to the September 1, 2012 Interlocal Agreement for Solid Waste Disposal Support Services for a Participating Community joining after July 3, 2023, together with such non-material changes as may subsequently be agreed to by the City Manager and approved as to form by the City Attorney.
