A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATE CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT AND SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE SEPTEMBER 1, 2012 INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH BROWARD COUNTY FOR SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL SUPPORT SERVICES FOR A PARTICIPATING COMMUNITY JOINING AFTER JULY 3, 2023, FOR THE PERIOD FROM OCTOBER 1, 2024 THROUGH JULY 2, 2028.

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works is responsible for the disposal of waste and waste services, which required an agreement with a qualified contractor to provide solid waste disposal services Citywide; and

WHEREAS, in June 2012, Broward County entered into an agreement with Wheelabrator Environmental Systems Inc., (“Wheelabrator“) to provide for the disposal of solid waste generated within Broward County; and

WHEREAS, on September 1, 2012, Broward County and various municipalities within the county entered an Interlocal Agreement for Solid Waste Disposal Support Services (“Interlocal Agreement”), which was later amended by a First Amendment, allowing each Participating Community to select Wheelabrator for waste disposal services and now, the City will be included in the Interlocal Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City was invited to join through a Second Amendment to the September 1, 2012 Interlocal Agreement for a Participating Community joining after July 3, 2023, and is renewed through July 2, 2028; and

WHEREAS, by participating in the Interlocal Agreement, the City will be responsible for the collection, transport, delivery and deposit of all the following waste: Yard Waste, Bulk Trash, Construction and Demolition Debris, Municipal Solid Waste (“MSW”) and Recyclables, at the following rates:

Residential MSW	\$56.15 per ton	
Commercial MSW	\$101.15 per ton	
Bulk/C&D	\$56.15 per ton	; and

WHEREAS, the City, as a Participating Community, acknowledges that the transportation portion of the Post-2023 Participant Disposal Services Fee is based upon Participating Community information regarding the composition and volume of Participating Community’s Residential Waste and Commercial Waste, which is estimated to be
